Underlined moves do not succeed. The French army in Rhr is dislodged and has only Holland open for retreat. The support order of the German Fleet Denmark is incomprehensible to the gamesmaster and consequently fails. The gamesmaster thinks he knows what was meant by the Austrian order to its unit in Rome; however, to order support to an Italian

fleet when there are no Italian units on the board is rather far out and this order likewise fails. Deadline for the retreat is Tuesday, 12 November. Deadline for Fall moves is Saturday, 23 November.
