1906 Fall retreat:

Russia (Kinney): No retreat received. Army formerly in Bulgaria
is annihilated.

1906 Builds and removals:

Russia (Kinney): Build army St. Petersburg. Build army Moscow.
Build army Warsaw.

Germany (Waus): Build army Munich.

Turkey (Reinsel): Remove fleet Albania. Remove fleet Greece. Remove
fleet Aegean Sea.

England (Tzudiker): No removal order received. Gamesmaster removes
fleet English Channel.

The previously announced deadline for Spring moves, 17 December,
falls in the period of the most congested Christmas mails. I think
it better to set it back to the date of the deadline of the other
game, namely, Thursday, 26th of December. Many players have
already submitted Spring moves. If they wish to change them they

England (Harris): Fleet Mid-Atlantic Ocean to Western Mediterranean.
Fleet Western Mediterranean to Tunis. Fleet Tyr-
rhenian Sea support fleet Western Mediterranean to Tunis. Army Paris.
stand. Fleet Livonia stand. Fleet Norway to North Sea. Army Moscow
support GERMAN army Warsaw to Ukraine. Army Edinburgh, undrdered,
stands.

Germany (Schow): No moves received. Fleet Gulf of Bothnia, and armies
Budapest, Galicia, Warsaw, Bohemia, Munich, Berlin,
Piedmont, all stand.

Turkey (Walker): Army Bulgaria to Rumania. Fleet Black Sea support
army Bulgaria to Rumania. Fleet Ionian Sea support
ITALIAN fleet Tunis. Fleet Aegean Sea support Fleet Ionian Sea. Fleet
Greece support fleet Ionian Sea.

Italy (Welsh): Fleet Tunis support fleet Naples to Tyrrhenian Sea.
Army Venice to Rome. Army Albania stand. Fleet Naples,
not ordered, stands.

Austria (Powlesland): No moves received. Armies Tyrolia, Trieste,
and Serbia, all stand.

Russia (Long): No moves received. Armies Ukraine and Sevastopol both
stand.

France (Celestre): No move received. Fleet south coast of Spain stands.

Underlined moves do not succeed. The Russian fleet Rumania, being
dislodged and having received no orders, is annihilated. There are
no retreats. As a result of these moves the belligerents control
the supply centres listed on the next page.

England: 3 home, Norway, Denmark, Holland, Brest, Marseilles, Moscow. Nine in all. May build 1.

Germany: 3 home, Sweden, Belgium, Paris, Warsaw, Budapest. Eight in all. May build 1.

Turkey: 3 home, Greece, Bulgaria, Rumania. Six in all. May build 1.

Italy: 3 home, Tunis. Four. No adjustment.

Austria: Vienna, Trieste, Sebia. Th ree. No adjustment.

Russia: St. Petersburg, Sevastopol. Two. No adjustment.

France: Portugal, Spain. Two. No space for additional build.

Deadline for builds would normally be the 19th of December at the height of the rush in Christmas mail. The deadline is accordingly set back a week to Thursday, 26 December. However, as is usual with build moves, if all are received ahead of deadline, publication may be advanced. Deadline for moves for Spring 1906 is, in any event, Tuesday, 7th of January 1969.

Byzantium, 23 Sept.
