BERLIN: The high command in Germany has fired all of its Intelligence Agents today. The reason given--that they did not lend or supply aid help as to who was allied with whom. The High Command would be very happy if somebody would shed some light on this matter. (It is terrible to be left in the dark) There have been reports that the Austrian Government has sent two divisions of armed troops up to the German border. These armies are being watched and will not be molested if the Commander of the Austrian forces would clarify his intentions. In other words, **GET THE HELL OUT OF THERE.**

PARIS (April 8, 1903): After a top secret meeting of the French Military command here, President Robaire le Formidable announced the basic French ambitions for this decade. He pledged that the war against the English dogs will continue to try and save the peoples of Europe from this war. He mentioned assistance from other Nations would be forthcoming. But these powers were not named. The latest attack by French forces on the English Channell to support the league of Mini-States attacks on the Cliffs of Dover and the Channal Islands. The great Admiral Conrad Anto Ludwig Antio Adolf Josef Wolfgang Freisner Von Metzke Dorffer is now on his way from Gaul to the anchorage of the fleet.
