

ISMIR: The Premier of the Turkish Hegemony looks with extreme displeasure on the movement of the Ukrainian fleets in the black sea. Informed sources indicate that the premier has ordered total mobilization along the northern frontier of the Hegemony but NOT deployment outside of Turkish holdings, pending further action on the part of the Ukraine republic. In other news, it was reported that the "Roving Ambassador" of the Balkan Union, A.Z. Djak arrived at Istanbul International Airport on a neutral flight armed with a sealed Diplomatic pouch. Considering the state of war that now exists between the Balkan Union and Turkish Hegemony, the shock of the daybreak both to reporters and Mr. Djak, was the extreme and cordial friendly treatment given him by certain members of the Diplomatic Corps, The Secret Police, and the Foreign Intelligence Agency, on hand to greet him. However the result of informal talks between the Premier and Mr. Djak was said to be that neither Country yet desires to reach any sort of accommodation on the terms desired by the other Country. But certain agreements on Prisoner-of-war treatment and exchange were reached, as well as a humanitarian agreement for elements of the Turkish Fleet on the Aegean and the Balkan Fleet in the Province of Athens to send aid in the form of food, Medicine, and blankets to recently earthquake ravished Corinth. At last report, Sailors and Marines from both units were working side by side, although somewhat uneasily, in the distribution of aid to the stricken Corinthians. Meanwhile, Sporadic fighting continued in Flodiv, Varna, and Vidin (Where it was reported that Balkan Troops have uncovered a site of a Ukrainian Atrocity, the Mass grave of 2359 Balkan women and children, machine gunned in their home.

The Cultural Trade fair in Sinope, sight of a series of excellent displays of Balkan trade items and culture, was said to be a resounding success with 53,000 attending the first week. One of those attending was the Premier himself, who said was said to remark on the great beauty of several of the Balkan exhibits. He was also rumored to have said; "It would be a tragic shame if this monument to the friendship of our two countries was to be sabotaged by any mis-directed actions of the Balkan fleets in the Black Sea, or the Balkan Fleets in the Crimea, against the territory of the Turkish Hegemony or her ally the U.S.S.R." It was here that the Premier decreed the Mobilization of all forces in the North, and in the Eastern Mediterranean.
