

THE CHALKER DELIMMA

Twice in the last two issues, I have said I would rule the same way that Jack Chalker did in Barad-Dur. I know clarify my stand. On Page four (4) "Rules of Diplomacy" By Games Research, It states "A unit moves with the strength of itself and all its supports, Unless it is opposed by a single unit equally well or better supported. The exceptions mentioned under "Conflicts" is that an order to move, with support against a unit belonging to the same Country as the moving or supporting unit is of no effect, that is, a Country may not force one of its own units to retreat. So here in review is the situation.

The whole situation rests on Kiel going to Berlin, and since Berlin attacked Kiel, it was forced to defend itself and could not move and since Kiel could not move, neither could Denmark move to Kiel since it cannot force one of its own units to retreat, therefore Holland could not legally support Den-Kiel under the rules of Diplomacy and Helgland could not legally support North sea into Denmark, since North Sea could not force Denmark its own unit to Retreat and since Denmark was not supported in its own providence It had to stand and fight the Russian units coming in with a force of two and therefore had to retreat. That to my mind is the only situation that could have occurred, It is the basic rules of Postal Diplomacy that the Gamesmaster make a ruling on all moves submitted, sometimes he is right and sometimes wrong in this case I will back Jack Chalker to the hilt, Many people may be offended but that is life you can't please everybody, NOW maybe thru this situation and the Koning situation, all Gamesmasters should call for a Convention of Gamesmasters and submit new rules to Games research to help clarify any new situation and alot of the old that have cropped up, why wait till we are forced to make an Interpretation of the rules, lets do something about it right now, I am sure there are many situations such as this that should warrant a changing of the rules. MUNICH 18-FEB-1903-1966-AM

His Imperial Majesty, the kaiser Frederick V, today reviewed the victorious Army of Bavaria, which successfully retook Munich from the nasty Italians last fall. In his speech commemorating the event His majesty noted that the Italians have now invaded the Austrian Empire and are ravaging Bohemia. "This affront to the dignity of our Eastern Germanic brethren will not go unpunished": His Majesty cried "Death to the Italians; Long live Austria; Long live Germany His majesty declared that nothing less than a complete public apology to both Austria and Germany by the Italian Government (if there is one) plus withdrawal of all Italian forces south of the Alps, would assuage German anger and wrath. His Majesty called upon France and Austria to aid him in ridding Europe of the perfidious Italians if they do not make full restitution by Spring, 1904.

WILTANCHESTER (10-JAN-1903)...Despite a cold wintry day, his Britannic Majesty Edagr III, spoke to a large crowd of citizens in the Capitol today. His Majesty hailed the great victories of British forces against the horrible Bolshevick Alliance in Denmark and North Russia. "Soon the heretics will be brought to their knees. Russia already trembles on the brink and can Germany be far behind. In alliance with the glorious State of France, we have pushed back the Huns everywhere; soon the pernicious doctrines of Marx will return to the dust from whence they came": His Majesty also announced that his Daughter, Mathaelde Plumnose was of marriageable age.

St. PETERSBURG (18-MARCH-1903)...The great Cathedral of St. Iwan was today the scene of a festive coronation. Rurik Vladimirovich Rurikam direct descendent of Tzar Rurik II of Kiew, was crowned Rurik III, Tzar of all Russias. In his first speech from the throne, His Imperial Majesty thanked most especially the King of England, The Emperor of Austria, and the Sultan of Turkey for enabling him to return to his rightful throne. His majesty expressed the hope that his allies would soon complete the Liberation of Mother Russia from the frightful Bolshevist yoke and prayed that they would remain in occupation of the Country until order and prosperity could be restored. His majesty was assured by the ambassadors of his allies that there was little danger of their leaving in the near future. His Majesty then journeyed South to the Front, where he observed the valiant British army harry the Cowardly Bolshevist Lackeys.

1966-AC *MOSCOW (23 April-1903)...His Imperial Majesty Vladmir III, today declared the official incorporation of Rumania, Armenia, and Sweden, in the Russian Empire. Further, in conjunction with the Patriarch of Moscow, Kvass II, his majesty declared a holy crusade against the infidel Turks. His Holiness the Patriach, his beard even more tobacco-stained than usual, declared that the holy seat of Constantinople must be liberated soon, before the presence of the Turks desecrate it beyond all redemption.
