

Now I know that most people publish much more frequently than I but, then John Boardman publishes in a shorter interval than anybody and he still trades with everyone. Well?



John Koning's newest venture, VALHALLA promises to be one of postal Diplomacy's milestones. Existing magazines have always been published for people who already are Dippy players but, VALHALLA from the start will be directed at the newcomer. Association with STRATEGY AND TACTICS (we consider it to be the best wargaming journal) will provide a permanent contact with the growing force of persons in all wargaming fields.

VALHALLA will carry one postal game, featuring the play of the "experts" (McCallum and Smythe), Diplomacy's human dictionary (who else but Peery), and your own trustworthy, loyal, and obliging editor. VALHALLA's pages will also contain feature articles on Diplomacy strategy and play and, what I consider to be most important of all, an address listing of wargamers of all types (Avalon Hill, Diplomacy, Gamescience, miniatures, naval, etc.).

In addition, the publisher (Koning) will offer extras for subscribers. A sample service will be provided to enable interested individuals to obtain a selection of Diplomacy magazines for a small fee and, in a few months time, a chance for subscribers to enter into as many games of postal Diplomacy as they wish.

VALHALLA #1 will be published on 13 April 1968, and will thereafter appear at tri-weekly intervals. The price is a bargain \$2.00 per year (17 issues); and for a super-bargain, John is offering a combination VALHALLA-STAB subscription for \$3.00 per year (34 issues). Dave Lebling, Box 2234, Burton House, 420 Memorial Drive, Cambridge, Mass. 02139 Your comparison of ratings with preferences is interesting, but I think your conclusion, that such a preference is the precursor of the future rating list,

is not justified.

For example, my own preferences would be: Austria, Germany, Russia, France, Italy, England, Turkey. I have no feeling whatsoever that this is how the future rating will look. I can, and have done well with Turkey and England. The reason I put them low is that they are uninteresting to play. Both have excellent chances of winning, but their strategies are limited to the extent that there is little fun in playing them. Exactly the opposite is true of Austria and Germany. Played well in the beginning of the game, both can win. But, both will go under very quickly if they are attacked right off by two of their neighbors. This occurs in game after game. In my own experience, Germany was attacked by England and France in 1966R, Austria in Miller's POC, PHC, etc., etc. A great many people don't like either country for this reason. I note that Austria is sixth in your list. Italy is a special case. It has the bleakest offensive possibilities of any power on the board. As far as most people are concerned there is either the sneak attack on Austria in 1901 or the slow build up of fleets to attack France, neither of which have a large chance of succeeding. Smythe tried, in Miller's PJC, to attack Turkey by building fleets and convoying to Syria, but due to various factors not under his control (read his allies) he was unable to make progress. Perhaps if someone has the courage to really develope this type of attack Italy will go up some in Preference.

It is very interesting to see such a tabulation of preferences published. Perhas you remember that Jared Johnson tried to get one about a Year or so ago, but response was small. If you eventually get more games going, or obtain figures from other people who give players a choice you might be able to get such

a survey yourself.

(Ed. Note. I really did not mean to imply that last issue's future country list would approach the actual configuration at some future date, rather I had planned to dwell upon the fact that trends could be recognized from a player's desire of position. Unfortumnately, space limitaions annihilated (?) further

Compiling a list of preferences from the AEOLUS games, substantiated and

brought to light a number of interesting ideas.

a) the length of time involved in Diplomacy is reflected in the player's list of desired choices. The longer the involument, the more inclined toward the

countries of diplomacy (Austria, Germany, and Russia).
b) All countries did receive a first place listing (Individual player lists);

and all of the countries did place last at least one time.

My preferences are likewise without similarity to the published list, Beside the reasons for choice that you have listed. I consider what countries the past. Incidently, a year ago when I entered 19676 (STAB) | listed both England and Turkey high on my preference card, having been in contact with Liplomacy for about 6 months. I oft desire one of the better starting positions at that time. In fact I asked Koning why new (to Elplopsey) players had seemingly received the choice countries. As you can see, a) above, is glose to figure, i.

John McCallum, Raiston, Alberta, Canada: Re the country preference on page 2. I wonder, It was pointed out long ago, I think by Koning, that popular choice Turkey was always much less enthusiastic than might be expected on account of its success. The reason suggested is that it is out of the action, Cipiomacy-wise, off in one corner of the board. It usually has lots of military action but, presumably, a player who wants a straight war game is playing Waterloo, or something, not diplomacy. The same feeling could be an important factor for the low preference for italy. Italy is the one country which coesn't have to get low preference for Italy. Italy is the one country which doesn't have to get involved immediately and can afford to stand aside and watch the action for a little before taking sides. But the implication of that is plain - it is not really involved in the diplomacy in the opening years in many games. And players certainly dislike playing Austria, although there are exceptions. Smythe, for instance, likes Austria.

There is another question which may influence preference in posts; games, i mean the propagands aspects. Nearly all of us have some familiarity with the bistory and literature of England, France, Germany, Austria and Russia. Which makes preparing press releases for them not too dificult. If others are like me they know less about Italy and Turkey, which would tend to make them less popular. Personal Train Andrews

(Ed. Note. If Smythe has an effection for Austria, Is it not true that you also have a similar attraction? As you say it is featy's thores, ususally, when to jump into the conflict. My one completed partials (tell, 196A1, was a case of jumping too soon. In this case the damage to Austria was irrepairable as Russia and Turkey were also bent upon Austrian ampinilation. Influence because of propaganca aspacts does not seem to be as much a factor in Turkish popularity as you propose. Since all players are not press release buffs, that would not seen to enter into the decision on preference. In fact the Turkish releases for 1968f are quite enjoyable (to me) and certainly are not hurting for a varied presentation scheme.)

tion of the word "space" in the Rules has already been interpreted (re: The Coastal Crawal) to mean that (e.g.) Spa(sc) is a different space than is Spa(nc). A dislocated unit may not retreat to:

- a) a space left vacant by a stand-off or
- b) the space from which it was attacked.

But for F Por, Spa(nc) is not vacant for either of those reasons, and it therefore seems to me that the Italian F Por may retreat to Spa(nc). Of course, if either or both of the French units in Spa and Mar had been armies, the rule would not apply. You will note in EREWHON, that I am adopting a house-rule (25) to allow exactly this sort of retreat. Like the coastal crawl, of which it is a corollary, this rule works only when all the units involved in movement are fleets. It is a very rare situation, and I don't recall a game (although there must have been one or two) in which it could have been used. It would apply only to a F Por being attacked by a F Spa (n or sc) and/or to a F Con being attacked by a F Bul (e of sc).

(Ed. Note. You've brought up a good point Rod, but I can only agree with you in part. The simplified version:

FRANCE: F Spa(sc) to Por; F Mid (S) F Spa(sc) to Por. ITALY: F Por Stand. F Por retreats to Spa(nc).

does work as it is complementary to the Coastal Crawl, However your continuation that a stand-off in Spa(sc) does not prevent a retreat into Spa(nc) seems to me to be contrary to the rules. After all the rulebook description of a fleet in a province having two coasts, includes, "It nevertheless occupies the entire province." The stand-off in your example would deny a portion of Spain to the retreating Fleet; a portion which would have been left vacant by a stand-off as per the rules of "THE Retreat". A stand-off in one coast of a two coast province, will be considered to be a stand-off in the entire province (at least it will in AEOLUS).)
