Subscriptions will be 75¢ an issue in North America, \$1.50 for overseas.

I intend to publish at least twice a year, more if the material I have on hand warrents it.

THE STATE OF THE MILLER NUMBERS....

I took over this job (for the second time) from Randy Grigsby in Nov of 1990. My main reason for doing this was that I, among many others, was very upset that Randy had ceased to do this job. The numbers are a very important part of the Variant hobby, and I didn't want to see them fall by the wayside. I intend to keep this job for a couple of years, and I hope to put the numbers back on track and keep them there. Now, let's try to explain the current state of things.

I have not received any of the MNC materials from Randy! When I took over all he did was tell me the last number that he had issued so I could immediately begin to issue numbers. This I have done from the very first day I took over. All number requests received by me have been sent out within 24 hours of thier receipt. I fully intend to keep this up except in rare cases (Vacations, etc). I have also tried to track down all of the games that I could that were running without numbers, and any games that had finished. I think I have done a reasonable job with this, but I'm certain that there are games out there that I'm unaware of.

IF YOU KNOW OF A GAME WITHOUT AN OFFICIAL MILLER NUMBER, PLEASE REPORT IT TO ME!

The negative side.....

I do not have any of the MNC records. Old games, records of all of the past numbers issued, subbers mailing lists, and most importantly, the MNC treasury. I have called Randy several times, I have written him, but it is now 3 months, and I have nothing.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Without a mailing list I don't even know who to send this to! Without old records I can't answer many of the questions that have been asked.

Without knowing what was the last number issued in years other than 1990 I can't issue numbers for games started before that that are running without a number. I am working on a solution to this.

Without the treasury, I am paying for this 'zine out of my own pocket. Thankfully a few people have been very generous and sent me a few bucks to help me out. Fred Davis, Melinda Holley, Doug Kent, and Fred Hyatt come to mind. If I failed to mention you, please forgive me.

I do not want to charge people for a Miller Number. I never did this before, and I don't want to start now. In the past, there were always people who sent donations, and this was usually enough to keep this service running. Sometimes there were contributions from various hobby auctions etc. So, I will continue to offer this service for free, and I will hope that finances will work themself out as they did in the past. As far as the rest of the problems go, I hope that someday, somehow, I can get all of the stuff from Randy.

WHY ARE YOU GETTING THIS?

Without a mailing list, I decided to find all of the people that I could, from various sources, that run Variant games. All of those people are getting a copy of this.

WHO WILL GET NEXT ISSUE?

Anyone who subs, tells me that they already paid Randy for a sub, anybody who wants to initiate a trade. I would also appreciate any of you that know of anyone that you think should get this to tell me. I'll make sure that they get a copy.

WHAT'S IN HERE?

All of the 1990 starts that I issued, and all end games that were sent to me.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

If you are running a 1989 game after 1989JU, or are running a 1990 game before 1990V, I'd like to know about it. That is the major gap in my records. Games prior to 1989JU are in old issues of A&O.

If you had agame end in 1990 and that endgame isn't in here, I'd appreciate a copy of it. If you did send it to Randy, send me another anyway.

If you happen to be playing in a game that doesn't have an official MN, please let me know about it.

THE STATE OF THE TREASURY.

I haven't taken this to the printer yet, but I know thier rates, and I estimate that I will be about \$20 in the red after sending this out. I expect to be able to give you a more accurate report by next issue. SUMMING UP.

I guess I may have rambled on a bit too much, and I may also have been a bit redundant in parts of this, but I am so damn frustrated by all of this. When I take on a responsibility of this sort, I try my very best to do a good job, and the total lack of cooperation from Randy has made the job very difficult. So, if you have asked a question I haven't answered, or not answered satisfactorally, I can only ask that you bear with me, I'm doing the best I can.

I'd also like to personally thank all of you who wished me well, and were very kind in thanking me for taking over this job. It is nice to know that somebody appreciates what you are doing.

Next issue I will try to not complain about anything. I don't like doing it anymore than you like reading it.

REMEMBER THERE ARE 2 OF US!

Some of you are a bit confused about the fact that me and my son are both in the hobby. I am Lee Sr, he is Lee Jr. He publishes Get Them Dots Now. I publish WHY ME? Lee JR is also the Variant Bank Custodian. That's the service that supplys you with maps/rules/etc for games.
