Sequential Diplomacy
by Nicholas Hoyle

1. All the boring old rules of Diplomacy (1971)
apply, except...

2. Movement is sequential, not simultaneous. For
the first seven seasons the GM will draw up a schedule
which will be the order in which the moves are to be
adjudicated. After seven seasons the schedule will be
changed. At no time will the players be informed as to
what the schedule was for any given season. Sequential
movement would mead that if both Austria and Russia
ordered armies to Galicia, and Austria's move was taken
first, the Austrian army would get in, while the Russian
move would fail as it would be prevented by the
Austrian unit which got there first.

3. Support for the units of another power is
permissible by means of a contract. If both players
inform the GM of their co-operation, then the units
concerned in supporting each other may do so
simultaneously - but their orders will take place with the
orders of the country which is the lower of the two on
the sequential movement schedule.

4. Retrospective support is permissible - thus Austria may order A(Bud) S A(Vie)-Gal to dislodge a Russian A(Gal), and then order A(Rum) S A(Vie in Gal). Such support by A (Rum) for the newly arrived Austrian army in Galicia would only work for moves taken after Austria, and would itself be conditional on A(Vie)-Gal succeeding. Obviously any conventional support for a unit standing would not be effective until that country's orders have been adjudicated.

5. Note that it is not necessarily an advantage to be higher on the list. For example, France may come first with A(Par) S A(Mar)-Bur, and then Germany could follow up with A(Ruh) S A(Mun)-Bur which would dislodge the French A(Bur) [assuming no retrospective support was forthcoming for the French A(Bur)].

6. If the GM wishes he can include the odd simultaneously adjudicated season, just to confuse the players. However, for every season sequential seasons, the schedule drawn up by the GM must put each country first once, second once, and so on.

7. Builds/removals are made simultaneously after every Autumn season.

Extra Supply Centers

by Jef Bryant

Introduction:

The main goal of this variant is to augment the diplomatic exchanges between players. As a power cannot use directly his ESC's he must communicate with another player.

The consequence of ESC's disappearing when a player is about to be eliminated may encourage another player to keep him alive, especially if he is using that player's ESC's.

(1) All the rules of classic Diplomacy (1971 version) apply with the following modifications below.

(2) Each country at the start of the game has two extra special supply centers (ESC). These ESCs do not count towards the victory criterion but are used to maintain units during the Winter adjustments.

(3) The ESCs will be abbreviated according to their origin, i.e. for Germany the two ESCs will be known as Ger1 and Ger2.

(4) A player cannot use his own ESCs for himself. The only ESCs that he can use are those "lent" to him by another player.

(5) This variant is © February 1993 by Jef Bryant and can be published only if a copy of the publication be sent to Rue Jean Pauly, 121, B-4430 ANS, Belgium. Copies can be distributed freely for postal play and variant banks. Any modification of this variant is prohibited without permission of the designer.

(6) If a player wishes to "lend" one or two of ESCs to another or two different players he simply sends the instruction to the GM along with his normal orders. The "lending" of ESCs to other players can be changed at any time by issuing new instructions and sending them with the normal orders.

(7) Any changes in ownership of ESCs will take effect practically during the Winter adjustments. All the ESCs will be shown in the game report and who is borrowing them.

(8) When a player is eliminated from the game his ESCs are also eliminated.

Mind Reader

by Eric Brosius

Use the standard rules of Diplomacy, except as follows:

1. Each Spring and each Fall turn, each player may select one of his or her units as a Mind Reader. A different unit may be selected each time, or the same unit may be used repeatedly. A player is not required to choose a Mind Reader.

2. The Mind Reader may read the mind of any other single unit on the board. The Mind Reader's orders may be conditional upon the orders given to that other unit for the **same turn** (though not upon whether those orders succeed or fail).

3. A Mind Reader which tries to read the mind of a Mind Reader is confused and is ordered to hold.

4. If a game has a GM, the GM reveals which units are Mind Readers and which unit's mind each Mind Reader tried to read. Only the order the Mind Reader is actually given is revealed, however, not the complete set of conditionals.
