Underlined moves fail. During the Summer of 1903, the French Army dislodged from Munich retreated to Silesia, as reflected in the above moves. The German A Holland is dislodged, and, having no place open for a retreat, it is annihilated. Austria-Hungary, England, and Italy may each build a new unit (Italy gained no new supply centers, but had a unit annihilated in the Spring). France, Germany, and Russia remain constant. Turnover, a private secretary of the aide of the

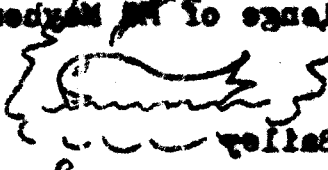
