Addenda: It should have been noted in the last issue that the French orders misplaced an army in Holland, when in fact it is in Belgium. That's a German army in Holland. Also, the gamesmaster (excuse me, Jim,) the European Concertmaster has found the rest of the Russian orders for Fall 1902, which he mislaid. The missing moves (all of which succeeded) are as follows: F Sweden-Skagerrak; F Norway (S) F Sweden-Skagerrak; A Finalnd-Sweden. Accordingly, the English F Skagerrak retreated to the North Sea. The Russian, German, and English players have previously been informed of this.

Note: Germany and Turkey gained no new supply centers during 1902, but each built because unit was lost through an annihilation.

PRESS RELEASES:

BUDAFEST (25 September 1914): The Banner of St. Stephen, official paper of the Imperial Hungarian Government, today announced that the death of former Austrian Emperor Franz-Josef, along with the entire Imperial family, in the fire which destroyed Schonbrunn earlier this The paper also emphatically declared that the personage in Switzerland who claims to be Franz-Josef is an imposter. Imperial Chancellor, Count Ritorno Vincitore, noted that "Switzerland is full of imposters, of course. It is not surprising to find one claiming to be the late Emperor of Austria."

PRAGUE (3 October 1914): His Highness Caesare Bordsha, brother of the Empress and Grand Prince of Transylvania, arrived here today to take command of the Austrian II, III, IV, and V Armies in the current campaign against Hermany. His Highness, fresh from his successful campaign against Rumania, promised that the Second Reich would be the last German state in Europe and would soon be eliminated. "The Slavs and Hungarians shall restore their rightful frontiers in the West." His Highness proclaimed.

BUDAFEST (31 October 1914): All Budarest danced tonight as the entire capital of the Hungarian Empire celebrated the birthday of Her Majesty the Empress. Her Majesty, accompanied by His Imperial and Most Magyar Majesty Roltan II, Her husband, greeted several hundred invited guests at the Imperial Palace, including some of Her closest friends: Dr. Fu Manchu, the Chinese Ambassador; the Count of Dracula; Dr. Karl Frankenstein, Count of Frnakenstein and noted scientist; His Holiness Pope Innocent XIV, Her Majesty's father; Miss Mata Hari, a childhood friend; Dr. Moriarty, prominent English businessman and savant; the Marquis de Sade, prominent Franch philosopher; Brother Rasputin, a Russian monk and well-known theologian; and James Latimer III, prominent American Diplomacy player. "I'm sure you'll all get along," said Her Majesty to Her special guests."

NORTH ANDOVER, MASS: The North Andover Times, official paper of Merrimack College, empha tically declared that the personage in Budapest who claims to be James Latimer III is an imposter. In a front-page story, the paper editorialized, "Hungary is full of imposters. It is not surprising to find one chaiming to be one of the world's greatest Diphomacy players."

PARÉE ((We've got a Spamish major here, folks.)): Premier Clemency stated today that the invasion of neutral Belgium by the German Hoards was an act of outrageous barbarism. He stated that France would do all in its power to help Belgium regain its independence—short of declaring war on Germany. "We shall bomb only military targets, and we shall always be ready to negotiate a settlement, say, a North and South Belgium. In the meantime, we will help to rehabilitate the Belgian people." During a Press Conference period, the Premier expressed sympathy for the cause of the victorious Hungarians, led by Zoltan II and Lucrezia, of whom he has heard much.

FIUME (December 1914): "Lucrezia I am Coming," Pope Innocent XIV was heard to say as he stepped off the "Holy Barge" at Fiume. Lucrezia was originally given to hungary Zoltan II as a prize for a pizza eating contest. It is believed Zoltan had to marry her because "he didn't know what he was getting into." The Austrian Underground was gracious engugh to supply a Russian weight-lifter to masquerade as Lucrezia; at last report Zoltan has yet to see the ruse. It is reported that Lucrezia is going to Genoa to entertain the troops with her "Dirksen" and "Flipper" imitations.

GENOA: Rioting has enveloped the city since Lucrezia's arrival seven days ago at the Entertainment Hall. The orge which followed found Lucrezia beseiged by 15,000 Italian wives (for what is best unsaid).

Effective immediately, Charles Brannan replaces Ernest Carrillo as Russia in this game. Carrillo is dropped for failure to submit moves or momey (guess which caused him to be replaced!).
