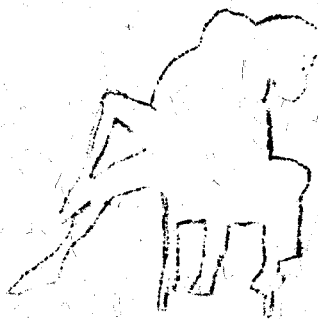

Many of you may be wondering about the delay of this issue. It seems that school delayed me along with a temporary shortage of money. Again, I will have to state that this will not happen again but that I am going to lengthen the publishing schedule to about 6 to 8 weeks during the school year and to monthly during the Summer. I hope that this will be satisfactory as I do have other activities that I must do.

The people participating in postal Diplomacy seem to be unable to even put down a "yes" or "no". This was the case with a recent poll in EREHWON on the Just Right-Hand Rule. France (Gordon): Army Paris to Burgundy; Army Marseilles S Army Paris to Burgundy. Fleet Brest to Mid-Atlantic.

Germany (McLeod): Army Berlin to Prussia; Army Munich to Silesia; Fleet

Kiel to Denmark.

Austria (Ogle): Army Budapest to Serbia; Army Vienna to Bohemia; Fleet Trieste to Albania.

Italy (Reiter): Army Venice to Tyrolia; Army Rome to Venice; Fleet Naples to Ionian Sea.

Russia (Tretick): Fleet Sevastopol to Rumania; Fleet St. Pete. to Bothnia; Army Moscow to Livonia; Army Warsaw to Ukraina.

London (April 10, 1901): (A letter written by an English traveler in France).
