CONCERNING THE RULES (Cont. from Page 20) -- Item 7 (Cont.):

- q. Revolutionary Armies may be moved from province to province, one province per season, one V at a time, regardless of the number of Federal military units which already occupy the province (subject to exception noted below in section r). Each such entry into a province by a Revolutionary Army sets off a Revolution in that province (beginning at Stage 0, but without necessity of Sabotage).
- r. If a Federal military unit (A, F, T, C, or H) occupies a province at the start of a season, and is ordered to "Hold" for that season, any Revolutionary Army attempting to enter that province is stood off.
- s. Once Stage 6 is reached, the Revolutionary may use the captured province as his home territory, and begin massing military units by constructing (unless captured with the province) a Shipyard or Arsenal, and then either building a C or T, or converting a Revolutionary Army to a C or T (by making up the difference between the cost of building a C or T and the cost he paid in building the V). Military units so built or converted are just like any other C or T in the game.
- t. If any Federal troops remain in a province when Stage 6 is reached, they are taken prisoners by the Revolutionary, to do with as he wishes. He may add $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Ag, I, and \$-factors tied up in the captured units to his own stockpile (the remaining factors are lost), and may add to his stockpile one M per captured C or T (with the remaining M's being treated as surrendered prisoners, under Rule #31).
- u. Once a Revolutionary Government is formed, it may apply for admission to the W.O.R.L.D. (a positive vote for its admission being construed as recognition of the Revolutionary Government by the nation casting the "Aye" vote). It may apply for recognition either as a separate "nation" from the nation on whose territory it rests, or as the "legitimate" government for the host nation.
- 8. Henceforth order to fish (ff) must be included in player's orders each season or FF will stand unordered.
- 9. Rules 36 through 39 are suspended for the WINTER, 1901 season. Whether they are dropped entirely, or are later reinstated (probably in revised form) will depend upon how fast the suspended functions are assumed by the players themselves, through national banks, international trade, the W.O.R.L.D. Bank, and the like.
 - 10. We hope to have Gold income rule and revised disaster rule ready by A.A.! #8.

When On-Board nation, or Off-Board W.O.R.L.D. member is vacated, it will be in "Civil Disorder" until assigned to new player. When Off-Board nation not on W.O.R.L.D. is vacated, it simply disappears from game (can be picked up again by new applicant).

In "Civil Disorder" as the result of resignations are: SERVIA (Huddle ston), SWITZERLAND (Bounds), JAPAN (Rintoul). In "Civil Disorder" as the result of missing two consecutive moves are: PERSIA (Swenson), ARABIA (Boskey), NORWAY (Evans), BULGARIA (Just); any of these persons can remain in game by sending in valid orders before the WOl deadline (providing the W.O.R.L.D. has not formally taken control of his country as a "Trust Territory" under the W.O.R.L.D. Charter).

Anyone interested in taking over <u>any</u> of the above countries in Civil Disorder should so notify the GM before the <u>WOl</u> deadline. If the W.O.R.L.D. has not bestirred itself and acted to assume control, and the owner has not sent in a valid set of WOl orders, the GM will give you control of the country. Off-Board Waiting-listers have first preference; newcomers who pay \$1 fee have 2nd preference; Off-Board W.O.R.L.D. members have 3rd preference.

Completely out of game are HORTA (Zumstein) and SARAWAK (Von Metzke); these players may remain in game by naming new (valid) country by WOl deadline.

II. FALL, 1900 Official Declarations, etc. --

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY:

The Austrian government cedes the southern one-fourth of the province of Bosnia to Chris Hawkins. The ceded portion will be called Bosnia, the remainder will be renamed Trieste. The agricultural and industrial yield per season for Bosnia is 1 Ag and I I. For Trieste it is 3 Ag and 3I. #### The Austrian government also cedes the shipyard in Bosnia to Chris Hawkins, and it is now situated in Bosnia. ((Bosnia will be charged maintenance costs unless A-H elects to pay them starting in WOl; A-H will be assessed FOO maint. costs in WOl unless other arrangements are made by WOl deadline.)) #### Bosnia now borders on Servia, Montenegro, Trieste, and the Adriatic Sea. Trieste borders on the Adriatic, Bosnia, Hungary, Austria, Tyrolia, Venetia, but NOT Servia! ((Bosnia also borders on Hungary, as province boundaries must be clearly separated, and you specified that Trieste not border on Servia.))

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY/BOSNIA: PACT OF BOSNIA

The newly-created state of Bosnia and Austria-Hungary enter into the following agreement.

- I. One-half the industrial (I) factors produced within the territory of Bosnia (rounded to the nearest integer in favor of A-H) shall be directly transferred to A-H every turn starting WOL. These will automatically come to A-H, no matter what the situation in Bosnia.
- II.l.A-H will at all times honor the boundaries of Bosnia, and any state that shall include the territory of Bosnia by Bosnia's voluntary:consent.
 - 2. Bosnia shall at all times honor the boundaries of A-H.
- 3. Bosnia shall never support any military action or economic sanctions against A-H or her allies.
- III. No part of this agreement may be terminated without the consent of both the legal ruler of A-H and the legal ruler of Bosnia.

OFFICIAL POLICY STATEMENT ON SERVIA GERMANY:

Although Germany is honored that Servia desires that it be made into nothing more than a vassal state, we believe that this would go against the intent of the Gamesmaster, and against the principles of W.O.R.L.D. I therefore decline.

However, as a member of the W.O.R.L.D. Trusteeship Council I do not wish to see Servia go leaderless. So until I can discuss this problem with Ron Bounds to find out just what should be done with Servia I wish to set a precedent, and write its orders myself for the Trusteeship Council. I personally favor that people who are not now in the game should be given a chance to volunteer for the position. However, if no one steps forward then the ex-player's desires should be adhered to. Of course, if no one volunteers, and no one is named for the position, then it's up to the Council to find a trustee.

Assuming that Don Miller doesn't frown, and say that's a "No-No", I will write Servia's orders along these lines until a trusteeship is set up:

Servia's foreign policy will be initially independent from Germany's.

- Servia will not declare war unless actually attacked.
- Servia supports the idea of a United Balkania, and will do anything (non-violent) in order to make it come about.

RUSSIA/AUSTRIA-HUNGARY/CARPATHIA -- TRADE ROUTES AGREEMENT

The Contracting Powers, Russia, Austria-Hungary, and Carpathia, hereby form a free trade area. All trade from one Contracting Power to another which passes through the territory of the third, or through seas occupied by naval forces of the third, shall be given free passage by that third party. All trade between Russia or Austria-Hungary and some outside power shall enjoy free passage through Carbathia, and all trade enjoying free passage through Russia or Austria-Hungary shall enjoy free passage through Carpathis. All trade through Russia or Austria-Hungary which is tolled by them shall enjoy free passage through Carpathia.

RUSSIA/MONTENEGRO -- TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT

1. Russia agrees to assist Montenegro in the development of its industrial and agricultural technology. Every season, Russia will pay for one industrial and one agricultural technology program in Montenegro.

- 2. Should a technology program supported by Russia be successful, the research benefits thereby received will be assigned to Montenegro for a period of one year. Following the termination of this period, after which time the research benefits will become permanent in Montenegro, the research benefits will be reassigned to the jurisdiction of Russia. The costs of this reassignment will be borne by Russia. All such research benefits will remain with Russia until Russia chooses to reassign them to Montenegro or to some other power.
- 3. This agreement will be valid when Montenegro and Russia have officially approved it. Russia may denounce it at any time, which would simply cause the termination of Russian financial assistance. However, any research benefits which at that time had been assigned to Montenegro for less than one year would go to Russia after that year in exactly the same manner as if this agreement still remained in force. #### Montenegro may also denounce this agreement at any time. In this event, any and all research benefits which had been achieved as a result of this agreement would go at once to Russia. #### Both parties, by a joint declaration, may denounce this agreement, in which case they may specify what should occur to any research benefits achieved thereby. They may also amend it as they see fit.

Stockholm -- Due to new address and many, many problems the diplomatic wing of the Riksdag has been held to a bare minimum this season.

DENMARK: Denmark claims the territory of Greenland. Greenland will be colonized by Denmark in the near future. The official name of Denmark is Kongeriget Danmark (or Danmark).

DANMARK:

The King of Danmark has announced the formation of the Royal Bank of Danmark. It will:

- 1. Act as a depository for all funds of Danmark.
- 2. Purchase gold at 100 Krone per gold factor.
- 3. Issue a gold-backed currency for use in internal and external trade.
- 4. Redeem its currency for gold at the rate of 100 Krone per gold factor. The Bank will assume further functions in the near future.

GREECE: The Greek govt. demands an investigation and/or clarification of claims made by RUMANIA concerning Spanish/Venezuelan conspiracy.

The King of Hellas is happy to announce ratification for Rumania's charter for the organization of the Balkan States for a one-term year only, to begin the Fall

of 1900 and to be re-ratified or rejected the Fall of 1901 or earlier. This is done until a formal charter is agreed on.

Greece is happy to establish a currency Bourse. Currencies are bought and sold at orices determined by demand and supply. The Greek government has loaned the Bourse 500 Drachmas to initially finance the bourse. No other currency is available yet. More details will follow.

MOROCCO: The Bank of Morocco will issue 100 paper dollars for each gold unit deposited in the Bank. These dollars will be redeemed for gold upon request.

MOROCCO -- CHARTER OF THE BANK OF MOROCCO

- 1. The Bank of Morocco will be run by the Moroccan Government.
- 2. It will store gold for all nations.
- 3. Upon delivery to the Bank 100 paper dollars will be placed in the sender's account for each gold unit sent.
- 4. The sender will have the option to redeem his gold units upon request in blocks of 1 gold unit for 100 dollars.
- 5. Only off-the-board countries will be able to buy bonds which will be redeemable in three years at 10% interest.
- 6. When the United Corporation of Morocco is established (probably next season) the Bank of Morocco will become a part of it and handle all its funds.

All nations are reminded that Winter is a free-trade season insofar as the transfer of gold factors to banks is concerned. Now is the time to deposit your treasury or to convert it into currency. Utilize the services of your bank during this special Winter period.

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY -- AN OPEN LETTER TO THE PEOPLES OF EUROPE

I, Lorenz III, Emperor of Austria-Hungary, have two very important announcements to make that will affect the entire world.

First, I hereby free the southern portion of the territory of Bosnia. The people there have elected Chris Hawkins as their temporary leader. The freed portion will retain the name of Bosnia, while the remainder is renamed Trieste. This act on my part is to assure the Balkan peoples that they have nothing to fear from their large neighbor to the north.

Second, I have positions open in my cabinet for governors of the provinces in my country, and for leaders of the armed forces. These are NOT purely puppet positions. I hope to find the right men or women to fill the posts, and they will be intrusted a sacred duty.

I would lastly like to assure the world that we are peaceful. I realize that our attack on Italy will not be regarded as in the best interests of peace, but we assure you that it is necessary. From this moment on, I, as leader of the Austro-Hungarian people, will act only with the help of any advisors I may have, in the best interests of Europe.

THE VATICAN -- FORMATION OF VATICAN CITY

It is written, in Our holy Book of the Future (A History of Tomorrow), that an independent papal state, known as The Vatican City, was created by the Lateran Treaty of Feb. 11, 1929, between the Holy See and the Italian regime. This state was located within the city of Rome, on the right bank of the Tiber, and occupying the east slope of Monte Vatico with part of the ancient Ager Vaticanus. Total area was 108 acres.

But We can not wait that long. Already war-clouds gather over much of Europe. Italy, by her bellicose actions, has threatened to bring the military wrath of her neighbors down about her.

To insure the safety of the Vatican, We feel it necessary to acquire a landarea around the building, and to, through both sacred and secular means, acquire immunity from worldly acts against Us.

- 1. Contrary to what was stated in item #3, on pg. 18 of AA!#6, we are not going to draw detailed maps of all the continents and bring the Off-Board powers into the game militarily as well as economically and politically -- at least not yet. Actually, we have three choices here:
 - a. Leave the game as it is -- using the world map in AA!#6 to establish Tr-needs for trade routes only, but not allowing Off-Board nations to build any military units -- allowing them only political and economic participation.
 - b. Bring the Off-Board nations in fully, by drawing maps as stated in AA! #6.
- c. Allowing the players who comprise each continent to make their own choice. They may decide: (1) To remain "Off-Board", with political and economic, but no military roles -- as is now, i.e.; (2) To come fully into game; (3) To design their own game, to be played out militarily on their continent (but still allowing them economic and political participation in main game); such design could be an already-existing Variant (like Insurrection, e.g.), or could even be just plain Regular Diplomacy on a map of their continent; the winner of each fight for continental supremacy would eventually fight the winner of the European war into global version of Diplomacy.

We ask each "Off-Board" player to think about this, and let us know what you would like for the continent on which you are situated. We are particularly interested in hearing from those countries comprising South America, as it is the continent closest to being filled at this point -- but we also wish to hear from the rest of you. ((Personally, we favor choice "a", as, with dropouts, it is probable that the Off-Board players who feel like fighting will eventually get in European war as replacements, while those who joined as Off-Board nations because they didn't want to get fully involved would remain "Off-Board, playing with their money, etc. But choice "c" does have its own attraction...))

3. Effective WOl, Ag deterioration takes place before trades, loans, gifts, and the like, but after assessment for builds, maint., battles, etc.

- 4. In future, eff. WOl, GM will not allow some orders when costs during season exceed stockpile at start of season. For purposes of determining which orders will not be allowed, GM will execute orders in following sequence: (1) Maintenance; (2) Non-battle actions (e.g., move, stand, etc.); (3) Battle action (e.g., attack, hold, etc.); (4) Others, in order written by player (incl. builds, research, bids, trade, etc.). So be careful of the order in which your orders are written. (FRA, RUS, SPA, take note!)
 - 5. Remember, eff. WO1, rule #63 applies in <u>full</u> (i.e., one I shipping-cost per trade; <u>plus</u> trader must have appropriate number of Tr's on hand or trade will fail) (F00 was free-trade season, with no assessment for shipping costs.)
 - 6. Remember, WINTER seasons are free-trade seasons for sending \$ to Banks.

7. Add new Rule:

#69. During any season, a "Revolution" may take place in any province of an On-Board nation. This "Revolution" must be headed by a person who is not already playing any country in the game (either on-board or off-) -- such person to be designated hereafter as a "Revolutionary".

Procedures for conduct of a Revolution are as follows:

- a. The Revolutionary simply declares a "Revolt" in a given province of an On-Board nation. (He may use a fictitious name if he chooses, thus masking his identity and limiting communication with other players to that of his own choosing.
- b. During the same season in which he declares a Revolt, the Revolutionary must conduct Sabotage (any amount will do) in the province in which the Revolt is declared. (Thus evidencing backing by at least one nation in game. Name of backer may be kept secret from other players if desired.) Note here that backer will either have to foot bill himself for Sabotage, or will have to transfer sufficient funds to Revolutionary prior to declaration of Revolt.
- c. If the owner of the province in which the Revolt was declared (i.e., the "Federal Government") wrote an order for the building of a military unit (C, T, or H), Shipyard, or Arsenal in that province during the same season in which the Revolt was declared, the build is successful. However, he may build no additional military units (he may still move them in, though), Shipyards, or Arsenals in that province until the province has been purged of the Revolution.
- d. The presence of a Shipyard or Arsenal in the province in which a Revolt is declared has no effect on the success or failure of the Revolution. If the province is fully captured (Stage 6) by the Revolutionary, however, the Shipyard or Arsenal becomes the property of the Revolutionary, to do with as he sees fit.
- e. The success or failure of a Revolution is influenced by the presence of a military unit (C, T, A, F, or H) in the province. And, of course, the more such units in a province, the more difficult it will be for a Revolution to succeed. The following table describes the relationship between the number of military units (C, T, or H) in a province and the probability of success of the Revolution (as determined by CM by throwing a pair of dice:

- f. Any Federal military force in a province during the first season of a Revolution in that province has no effect on the Revolution, but is used solely to offset the Sabotage IAW Rules 64 and 65.
- g. Revolution and Guerilla Warfare (ref. Rule #64) may not be conducted in the same province at the same time. Should two or more players write such conflicting orders, the orders for Revolution shall take precedence.
 - h. The Stages of a Revolution are as follows:
- Stage -2 -- Revolution is put down by Federal Government. Revolutionary is killed (may not reenter game under same name).
- Stage -1 -- Revolution is collapsing. Revolutionary may escape if he desires; if he so chooses, Revolution ends. (Choice to escape must be made and so ordered season following entry into Stage -1.)

- Stage O -- Revolution has no effect. All Revolutions begin at this stage the season in which Revolt is declared, and automatically advance to Stage 1 at the start of the following season. (From this point on, all stage-changes occur at end of season, before assessment of costs and receipt of income.)
- Stage 1 -- I and Ag yields of province are reduced by 20%. Stage 2 -- I and Ag yields of province are reduced by 40%.
- Stage 3 -- I and Ag yields of province are reduced by 60%. At this stage a Revolutionary may order the establishment of a "Revolutionary Government" in the province (Until he does so, the Revolution may not proceed beyond Stage 3.) At the end of the season in which the Revolutionary Government is formed, the Revolutionary accumulates 40% of the normal I and Ag yields of the province. Such accumulation occurs each season thereafter until Stage 4 is reached, or until Revolution is set back to Stage 2.
- Stage 4 -- I and Ag yields of province are reduced by 80%. Revolutionary Government gains (and province owner loses) lM per season; he also gains 60% of I and Ag yields of province per season. (Note that a maximum of 3M's may be accumulated in any single Revolutionary Stage.) Such accumulation 4/1/3/4/4/4/6 occurs each season until Stage 5 is reached, or until Revolution is set back to Stage 3.

 Stage 5 -- I and Ag yields of province are reduced by 100%. Revolutionary Government gains (and owner of province loses) 1\$ plus 1M per season; plus 80% of I and Ag yields of province per season. Such accumulation occurs each season until Stage 6 is reached, or until Revolution is set back to Stage 4.

 Stage 6 -- Province is fully occupied by Revolutionary. Revolutionary Government.
- Stage 6 -- Province is fully occupied by Revolutionary. Revolutionary Government gains 100% of the I and Ag yields from province from this point on; plus whatever number of Gold factors (captured \$ included) will bring his gain up to 1/10th of the Federal Gold stockpile or 5\$, whichever is the smaller figure; plus whatever number (captured M's included) of M's will bring his gain up to 1/10th of the Federal M stockpile or 6 M's, whichever is the smaller figure.
- i. A Revolutionary may also accumulate Ag's, I's, \$, M's, etc. sent to him (via a legal trade route) from any of the countries on the board. Such accumulations are not included in those under Stage 6, above. (However, Stage 6 totals do include "invested" M's.)
- k. Once Stage 3 is reached, each Stage backwards the Revolution slides results in a loss of 20% of the Revolutionary stockpile to the Federal Government. If Stage -2 is reached, 100% of the remaining Revolutionary stockpile goes to the Federal Government. If the Revolutionary escapes under Stage -1, he takes with him 25% of his remaining stockpile, with the rest going to the Federal Government.
- l. An escaped Revolutionary may go to any place on- or off-board which will have him, under whatever conditions may be set up -- providing his escape can be traced over a legal "trade route". If his route passes through the territory or naval blockade of another country, and that country has not okayed the route in writing to the GM, the escaped Revolutionary and his remaining assets are captured by that country, to do with as it sees fit.
- m. Once Stage 4 has been reached, a Revolutionary may "export" his Revolution to neighboring provinces, one province at a time, one province per season, simply by declaring a "Revolt" in them, conducting Sabotage that same season, and proceeding from Stage 0 as in the primary Revolution. (This, of course, has the effect of greatly increasing the pressure on the Federal Government.) Such spreading of a Revolution is not limited to the provinces of the Federal Government in whose country the primary Revolution originated.
- n. Except as described under section m, above, a Revolutionary may not conduct more than one Revolution at the same time. (Also as noted in sect. q, below.)
- o. At any time after Stage 4 is reached, a Revolutionary may build a Revolutionary Army (V) in the province. Each such Revolutionary Army costs 1\$, 2M, 5Ag, and 7I to build, and 2Ag, 1I per season to maintain. No Revolutionary Fleets may be built, and the building of a Revolutionary Army does not require the prior construction of an Arsenal.
- p. Each Revolutionary Army in a province offsets the effect of one Federal military unit (C, T, or H) in the province. A maximum of four V's may exist in a single province at the same time.

PROPAGANDA FROM ELLAS

KOT LUSE ET

Athens: The Minister Extrondinaire's office announced the establishment of an official newspaper and news agency for distribution of news and communication from the Greek realm.

The two will have the same name, a revered ancient name - "Ellas".

Sounier: The financial community requests that all nations establish their exchange rate I \$1. There is at present a discussion concerning the founding of an international money market. At present we can offer only Greek Drachmas. Here is your chance to debase your currency or have the same fund the rulers in Europe had. Request all banks of a national nature to publish an official annual accounting of the amount of each type of currency in their vaults. (No need to mention whose account the currency is in.) More details will be announced this winter.

Piraeus: The latest edition of Camera (paper for the UPP) announces that the UPP leader - Mikhalis - desires more info on the Swedish Stock Exchange. Being Finance Minister of the present government, he feels this may be a source of good investment for the Greek peoples.

Athens: Minister of Commerce Biakonis (UPP) has announced that Greece will trade I units at the rate of 2I per 50 Dr. (0.5\$) and Ag units at 3 Ag per 50 Dr.

MAegina: Papaionnis of the Communists party announced in the Worker's Daily, that he bets on Russia in the wrestling match. Are there any takers? In an unusual situation the King of Hellenes is financially in favor of taking on any bettors - he also likes Russia!

Hydra: Treaty missions have been to Russia and Turkey. It is hoped by the Minister Extrodinaire that a favorable piece of news will soon arrive resulting from these missions.

Sparta: Alpha, news organ of the clerical Socialists (CS), editorialized in favor of desires, by the Finns, for freedom. Well remembering, and still realizing, the weight of outside orcupation, Greeks all over hope the Finns realize freedom. As for revolution, we know it well and, therefore, eaution the Finns to seek a peaceful solution first.

Athens: Minister Iannisjohnsonoupolos views with favor the formation of a United Balkania (as a confederation of Balkan states. He feels, however, to join the Rumanian plan without reservation is detrimental to our policies. He also voiced concern and disappointment that no one saw fit to answer earlier letters from Athens when the concept was first voiced. Since the idea is more important than the source, we will not quibble.

Athens: Vote on the acceptance of Rumania's charter was: For - 27; Against - 40; Abstain - 3; A compromise bill accepting the charter on a one year basis was passed, the vote being; For - 54; Against - 12; Abstain - 4. The UPP and CS changing their vote in favor of the compromise bill. Four members of the NU abstained on the second vote in a surprise move.

Athers: Defense Minister Onaxos (UPP) announced that the so-called Home Guard is only his Majesty's 3 regiments of Evzones who are required for various ceremonial and traditional duties. He applauds the fact that Denmark and Sweden have followed his footsteps and demobilized its armed forces. He finally noted that he was alarmed by the mobilization of somany nation's forces and fears clashes on the Italo-Austrian borders as well as the France-German borders. He has publicly hoped that Turkey and England continue their admirable stance of peace.
