Due to a great amountrof inconventence on the part of the two Gamesmasters, particularly in that Bounds had to travel out 9 miles at his expense every 2 weeks, and due also to the unavoidable faulty coordination between 2 people almost independently putting out 1 magazine, BARAD-DUR, with the 11th issue, will contain only games B and C. BARAD-DUR will be available from JACK L. CHALKER, 5111 LIB-ERTY HEIGHTS AVENUE, BALTIMORE, MARYLAND, 21207, phone (301)367-0685.

Games A and D will be published in a new magazine, to be called ORTHANC. This magazine (trade or 10/\$1.00) will be published by RON BOUNDS, 649 N. PACA STREET, BALTIMORE, MARYLAND, 21201 (301) SA-7-8202.

There is no delay to the change. Deadlines remain the same for all games, and the addresses of the Gamesmasters also remain the same. The only difference is those players in Games A and D who do not trade with BARAD-DUR and do not play in B or C will stop receiving this magazine, and receive only ORTHANC? Ditto, people in B or C who don't trade with Bounds, pay a buck, or play in A or D will receive only BARAD-DUR and not ORTHANC.

Aside from great advantages to gamesmasters, the split will allow the eventual formation of new games. An E game is planned for BARAD-DUR beginning the first quarter of 1966 if and when applications are received. New people, including those only in A or D and those not in any current Games Bureau Postal Diplomacy game will be encouraged to join E. Don't send money, however, until the game is actually announced, probably in February, but by all means apply.

Those players in A or D and B or C will, of course, received both magazines, under separate cover.

England, France, and Germany do not move, build, or eliminate, and thes stay constant. An error in the transcription of the fall moves eliminated the Turkish move FLEET BLACK SEA (S) A RUMANIA TO SEVASTOPOL. Thus, the Russian army Sevastopol was dislodged -- but could retreat to Ukraina, and did (above). The question of setting back the Spring, 1904 deadline to December 31 fails, since only 3 players voted on it. The question of players choosing which pieces to be eliminated passes, and effective with the next elimination period you'll write out an elimination order in every circumstance. The vote was 5-1 with 1 not voting. DEADLINE FOR YOUR SPRING, 1904 MOVE ORDER IS JANUARY 2, 1966. TELEGRAMS & CALLS ACCEPTABLE OF COURSE.

There are no retreats. The English convoy to Denmark is an illegal order; a fleet can not convoy overland, only across a body of water. In this case, the failure of Russia to move would make even a legal convoy impossible. For a roster of pieces and supply centers, and build/elimination instructions, see the next page.

GERMANY controls the following supply centers: Denmark, Kiel, and Berlin. She has units in Helgoland Bight, Kiel, Berlin, and Rhur. GERMANY MUST SUBMIT AN ELIMINATION ORDER DIRECTING THE REMOVAL OF ONE OF HER UNITS.

AUSTRIA controls the following supply centers: Trieste, Budapest, Vienna, Serbia, and Greece. She has units in Albania, Serbia, Greece, Galicia, & Tyrolia. AUSTRIA DOES NOT BUILD, STAYS CONSTANT.

TURKEY controls the following supply centers: Bulgaria, Constantinople, Smyrna, & Ankara. She has units in Aegean, E. Med., Bulgaria, & Constant. TURKEY DOES NOT BUILD, IS CONSTANT.

ENGLAND controls the following supply centers: London, Liverpool, Edinburgh, Norway, Belgium, & Holland. She has
units in Norway, London, Belgium, Holland, and North
Sea. ENGLAND MAY BUILD 1 UNIT IN EDINBURGH OT LIVERPOOL.

On the question of moving the deadline back to Dec. 31, this fails, receiving 3 YES, 1 NO, and 3 people not voting. On the question of voluntary elimination of pieces by order, the question passes 4-1 with 2 not voting. All players take note! No more automatic eliminations unless an order is not received.

PROPAGANDA

Wein, Nov. 12, 1902. Peace in our time! The Foreign Office today announced the signing of the Pan-Mediterranean Pact with France and Italy. The Foreign Office also announced that the talks with the Ottoman Empire have not yet come to a fully successful conclusion but will continue. In another development the War Office announced the formation of the 3rd Nazgul Bomber group, joining the 1st Nazgul Observation Corps & 2nd Nazgul "defense" group.

The Sublime Porte has released the following statement by the Sultan of Turkey, Abdul M'Banid: A state of war exists between the Obtoman and Austrian Empires. We must liberate the oppressed peoples of Greece & Serbia. We call on all nations of Europe, particularly Italy and Russia, to join with us in opposing the evil mechanizations of Franz-Jerald IV.

SOCIAL NOTE: King Gorice XII of Carcë is currently in Istanbul on a state visit to Sultan M'Banid.

Rome, Oct. 3, 1902 (Stefani). The Emperor in his capacity as Pope, has declared a Holy War on the Turks. His Maccabee forces shall add their strength to Austria's Nazgul forces to rid Europe of the Suoggoth Finks. FRANCE DECLARES WAR ON ITALY! France humbly apologizes for its occupation of Munich, but we hope to march south into Italy as well as East.

Whitehall protests Nazgul overflights of our fleet in the North Sea. Nazguls constitute a violation of the Geneva Convention, and whoever is doing it had better stop!

In a news conference Lord Gilliland suggested that the Emperor Franz-Jerald IV was either senile or an enemy agent. "Look at his so-called foreign policy. After finding Russia and Turkey allied against him he alienates and attacks Italy -- without success. Next do you suppose he'll try to grab Munich? Ach du lieber as they say in Mienna. "For a correspondent, he translated: Whom the gods destroy they first make mad.
