AUSTRIA holds Greece, Serbia, Budapest, Trieste, Vienna, & Warsaw (6), has 7 units on the board, MUST REMOVE 1 UNIT.

TURKEY holds Smyrna, Constantinople, Ankara, Bulgaria, Rumania, Sevastopol, Moscow, St. Petersburg (8), has 6 units, MAY BUILD <u>2</u>.

ITALY holds Venice, Rome, Naples, Marseilles, Spain, Tunis, Por-

tugal, (7). He has 6 units, and so BUILDS 1.

RUSSIA has 1 retreating unit, no supply centers. RUSSIA IS ELIM-INATED FROM PLAY.

Second Proclamation of the Revolutionary Council, to the Leaders of England: Beware the fifth column!

Whitehall offered political asylum to Franz-Jerald, beleade uered Emperor of Austria-Hungary today.

Sultan Abdul M'Banid, in a public speech from a balcony of the Seraglio, praised Turkey's ally, Russia. "Together we will bring peace to the Balkans and annihilate the perfidious Dual-Monarcy," said the Sultan.

Satiated with Ditch Chocolate, Danish Ham, and Kiel-burgers (a confection not unlike a Dagwood sandwich), King George VII expressed an interest in French cuisine.

There are no retreats. The German move of F Den-Norwegian obviously fails; the two areas do not border each other. I rep fer you to a Diplomacy map, Margaret. However, it's fortunate the move failed, since if you'd moved out of Denmark you would not have been there on a fall move and would not have built for it. The Russo-Turkish factor of 2 against Rumania stacked up evenly with Austrian forces, and Rumania remains vacant, ditto Beggium in a smaller battle. Build orders follow.
