Moscow (Tass): The Supreme Soviet today passed a resolution de-
nouncing "Jackal" Chalker, Fuehrer of Switzerland, for his part in
stirring up the warlike passions of the European family of nations.
The resolution went on to point out how of the four nations bordering
Switzerland, two had been wiped out and the other two were both
weakened and bound to fall soon. The resolution then called upon other
nations not to fight like lions while a jackal took over the field.

Byzantium-an-Dem-Rhein: Sultan Abu Ben Stegosaurus-
Mbabbib today told the British to "roll your entire foreign
policy in a little ball" and cram same in the nearest recept-
acle." He also announced his entire military policy through
1927, but the microphone had given out and nobody heard what
was said.

Bhagibhreeches, Dutch Guiana, Dec. 31: The Dutch Ad-
miralty confirmed today that the Dutch windjammer, fliegende
Hollander, with a lubber crew and a captain that can't count
the masts, surprised and "keel-hauled" the British West Indies
squadron off the crown colony of Jamaica, in face of overwhelm-
ing Dutch superiority the Royal Jamaica Cigar Works capitulated.
Stadtholder Van Diggert said that "Dutch diplomats incensed
over the recent British seizure of the Netherlands East Indies
(that about the Germans controlling Batavia and the 'outer is-
lands' was just some rot Huffleys had spread around), entered
the governor's mansion, and with broadsides of lethal schimmel-
pennicks, the Dutch diplomats overwhelmed their British oppo-
nents in the smoke-filled rooms and won the negotiations. When

London, April 20^m 1903 (Reuters): Sir Alfred Huffley announced today in Parliament that the South American continent had come entirely under British control. "Britain truly rules the world," Sir Alfred said, "Most of the Americas, most of Africa, half of Asia, all -- all ours! This is truly Britain's finest hour and so it shall ever be called, even if the Empire lasts a thousand years."

On other matters the P.M. said that British casualty rates in Europe, while heavy, were not as heavy as expected and not as heavy as any other power's. On the Italian question, he said that the Ambassador in Rome had restored peace.

Belfast, April 30, 1903: The pirate of the North Atlantic was sunk today by HMS Conquest, a fast battleship. The raider was an American privateer captained by some nut calling himself J.P. Jones.

Capetown, April 30, 1903: A young correspondent by the name of Churchill has been requested to leave the country for making insulting remarks about the Boers.

London, May 1, 1903: A Socialist-inspired worker's riot took place in many industrial cities today resulting in the destruction of several factories and the death of at least 2000 workers and police. The Socialist Party has been outlawed and its leaders arrested for treason.

Kiel: Germany has boycotted the French and English in protest to crimes on the high seas.

London: Students threw eggs and shouted protests against Prime Minister Huffley's unjust war on Germany.
