

This is the first anniversary issue of BARAD-DUR. It doesn't really seem like — this impression heightened by the fact that none of the games begun a year ago a finished as yet, although if things continue as they have been our 2nd anniversary will have only two familiar faces — XF and H, and maybe not even the latter.

BARAD-DUR was begun as the work of two persons -- Ron Bounds and myself. After 20 weeks of Ron coming 10 miles from the center of town out to my place to run the issue, though, we decided we'd better split in half. Thus was born ORTHANC. The two magazines have recombined for this issue only under the old format, as a birthday celebration. We've also arranged things in the proper alphabetical order for the last time for another year. If you want to know where "G" is -- wait a while.

Both magazines are affiliated with the NJF Games Bureau. As Diplomacy Division chief for the GB, I feel (particularly since I've been promising but not delivering one to Don Miller) that this is the place for a general Diplomacy Division report. Note & copy, Don Miller, please.

BARAD-DUR and DRTHANC are the only two N3F Games Bureau magazines. We would always welcome others, of course. We'd particularly like to see an N3F Bureau zine devoted to wild variants, but any and all Gamesmesters are welcome. OSGILIATH, the announced #3, has never seen print due to Jerry Jacks moving. He's mentioned nothing since about running it. Any volunteers?

GB Diplomacy magazines are basically independent publications. All we ask is a Gamesmaster to be a GB member, credit the GB in his magazine, and adhere to a standard rate policy, with all N3F gamesmasters agreeing on a hike, if any. Effective immediately, the GB Diplomacy magazine fees run as follows: REGULAR GAME: \$4.00; REPLAY (another game by someone already playing in one GB —— not 'zine but GB —— game):\$2.00. BARAD-DUR has an odd rate: add \$1.00 if you want your copies air mail. ORTHANC does not follow that surcharge.

No GB magazine, however, has any standardized rules, rating charts, etc. Bounds and my rules even differ slightly. Neither of us believes standardization of rules would be good for the progress and evolution of the game.

The rates above also apply to variant games after XF.

The game numbering system is simple: GB (for games bureau) -1966- (year game starts) -G. The first GB game was Bounds' A; my B started the same time. OSGILIATH took game G but never appeared, so the games run A (Bounds), B,C, (me), D (Bounds), E, XF (me), H (Bounds). The next game would be "G" to fill in, then we'd continue with I,J,K,L, etc. The "X" before a letter doesn't disturb the lettering order; it simply signifies that the game is not a regular 7-Man Games Research game, but a variant.

The Games Bureau, I understand, gives credits toward subscriptions to other GB publications for games played in an NSF Diplomacy magazine.

There's very little else to say. G will, most likely, be a "straight" game; as a science fiction fan "I" must be experimental -- "XI."

Berlin, Dec 3, 1905 -- The kasser made the following speech today from the top of the Brandenburg gate:

"My people! Germany is still fighting desperately for its life on two fronts. The English constantly press us from the North in spite of our true desire for peace with them. From the South, the Turks are testing our Russian borders in spite of our non-aggression overtures. Even France has shown herself to be at all trustworthy and even she betrayed us in Belgium, although probably because of the so-called "Mad Miller", the former foreign secretary that was assassinated last year. "Mad Miller" was called that because he was the son of a humble village miller. After wheedling a minor position in the Foreign office, he showed such skill at doctoring Diplomatic Notes, that he rapidly rose in power, finally having his predecessor assassinated so he could take over. Now, France is again at peace with us, and together we shall rid the North of the English Blight that has been rampant for the last four years."

A Deafening ovation from over 1,000,000 Berliners gathered to hear the speech followed, and the Kaiser was hailed as the saviour of his nation.

LORRY-DEVANT-LE-PONT, south of Metz (AP): The night is lurid with gunfire, as artillery further and further back is called into the battle on both sides. The Chevreaux des Meaux has repulsed two attempts by the Bavarian IIIvbI and II battalions (Franconian) since the sun has set. The French remain in possession of the Lattinally farmhouse at the edge of the Bois de la Comte, the Brey arm of the Bois de la Comte, and the feature known as "The Nose" to the Frenchmen of Pagny-sur-Moselle below on the other side of the Moselle River. The Nose is simply a bluff overlooking the balley and its northern companion, The Bottle, or Hill 7215, remains in German hands.

French patrols are now probing the Bois de Daumont to the southeast, and further reinforcements are reportedly on the way on both sides, the German Commandant of the IvaII Corps area (Metz) declaring that he will evict the French from their enroachments on German soil. At this very moment, Festung guns from Fort St. Privat are striking 65D years south of here in Mardient and the Bois de Mardient-et-Bouxieres-sous-Froidmont.

War may well be commencing on the European Continent at this very moment, the flaming spark that may turn the tinder-boxes of Europe into exploding fury.

SULTAN TO THE FEZ OF TUNIS: "Look! There's one boss in Islam and I'm IT!"

Stockholm, June 2 (kalmar Avisen) - The Second fleet, under Adm. Sven Borgund, received the Spanish surrender aboard the flagship Stockholm in Malmö harbor today, following the assault on the fortress by a squad led by Sgt. Johan Gadolin, Kalmar Marines, through the water pipes, drained by leaks caused by the shelling, which resulted in its capture with no loss to the Marines.

London, January 23, 1901: All Britain mourns the death yesterday of Queen Victoria. The Prime Minister and the Foreign Minister traveled hurriedly to Osbourne and spent the morning in conference with His Majesty King Edward VII. This afternoon Foreign Minister Sir Lyon Gandolphus Grey, announced that the change of reign would mean no alteration in England's continental alliences and commitments.



DICK SCHULTZ: Now for some gripes. You positioned the dot in Kiel over Hamburg (++But we traced the original map for that! |LC++). The proper name for Caucasia is either Transcaucasia or Circassia, after the old generic name for the peoples and lands of the Novorossik-Baku Caucasuses.((++Purists!JLC)).The proper Swedish term for the northern provinces is the Horjedalan, or that land beyond the Delecarlia, and the Sodermanland. A portion was known as Jemtland, belonging to the Danish-Norwegian sovereign from sometime in the 1100s when they converted to Christianity. Then Christiana, the sovereign after Gustavus Adolphus, annexed the land outright. In 1658 Charles X annexed the entirity of the land you marked Oslo.
