Alexis Gilliland has resigned from GB-1965-C in brotest over what he calls "gamesmaster errors." Although many gamesmaster errors have been perpetrated on long-suffering players, the point over which he resigns is not and was not an error, but a legitimate interpretation of the rules.

The moves in question (C, #27) run:

Of course it would have been simplicity itself for Russia to obtain uncontested control of Denmark -- if Sweden has supported instead of moved. However, Russia chose to go in with two, and I ruled it makes it. Why?

When the rules were written they had holes through which an armored column could be driven. This is one of them, known to give the shudders to all clean-living Gamesmasters -- a SITUATION NOT SPECIFICALLY COVERED IN THE RULES.

that Gilliland insists is the correct one would have the English F North Sea, coming in on Denmark with support from the Helgoland Bight, have a factor of 2 anyway and stand off the Russian attack.

I ruled, however, that under my understanding of the rules, the Russian attack succeeded, 2-1. This is based, most specifically, on the rule which states that no unit may be both moved and supp-

orted in the province from which it is moving.

All of Gilliland's moves depended on army Kiel being able to move into Berlin. Kiel could not move. Thus, Denmark could not move to Kiel. It stood alone in Denmark, and the two units trying to move into Denmark and cover its advance failed to make it. FLEET NORTH SEA WAS ORDERED TO MOVE, NOT SUPPORT. A supporting action is clearly impossible. F HELGOLAND BIGHT WAS ORDERED TO SUPPORT -- NOT FLEET DENMARK (which would have been illegal) BUT FLEET NORTH SEA INTO DENMARK -- impossible because Denmark did not move and you can not dislodge your own unit.

Thus, the North Sea and Hel.B supports were impossible, under the rules, and therefore Denmark stands UNSUPPORTED, a victim of

the two-pronged Russian attack.

If, however, we consider the English North Sea move to Denmark to be, in effect, an attack on Denmark and the unit in it, it would, indeed, stand off the Russian charge -- but only if F Denmark were not there.

If I were to accept that English move as an attack on its own position, which it would be, then it would follow that Kiel, during the same move, would have had a defense factor of 3 -- that is, A Kiel (which didn't go anyplace) plus the two units trying to get in. This makes it possible for a player to move his piece and support that square at the same time -- SOMETHING SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITED IN THE RULES.

Even if we ignore Kiel's factor, we have, down there, a defense factor in Kiel of 2, leaving Kiel to move. This is illegal. It is a blatant attempt to move, and, if unsuccessful, support the

province simultaneously.

There is no paradox, really. The situation is obvious. To rule that Denmark was not disloded, that North Sea and Helgoland Bight stood off the Russian attack, would be to drastically alter the very fabric of Diplomacy, for it would present in every instance an opportunity to insure an attacker's point of origin while leaving the attacker free to attempt a move. I do not believe that Diplomacy would be played as it is now played under that sort of ruling. In all cases, I would consider the very ruling which Gilliland argues is the proper one to completely change the game —— and introduce a new luck variable. Who wouldn't try one-shot guess attacks if he knows his own province can be covered in case the move fails?

In other words, a ruling different from the one I made in this

case would be, I would say, a variant game.

When you paid your game fee you paid for several services. You asked me to compile and publish your moves, and to INTERPRET THE RULEBOOK AS STRICTLY AS POSSIBLE TO THE BEST OF MY ABILITY AND UNDERSTANDING.

In this ruling, logic is on my side -- and so is the rulebook. However, Alexis seems to imply in his letter, "You play by MY interpretations or I don't play." Well, run your own magazine, then. Mine is played by the book, and that's the way I think DIRLOMACY should be played.

Gilliland has been replaced by Mark Owings (see C) who has declared civil government in France collapsed. He is the logical replacement, since he knows the game and the players — and the alliance system. He was an ally of England's.

In XF another situation came up. It could come up in 7-man. Viz! F W. MED TO MID-ATL. (Italy). F ENGLISH CHAN TO MID-ATL (GB).

but, France, F BREST TO MID-ATL; F BASC (S) BREST-MID-ATL.
Who makes it? I say France does, and did, in XF. It did so
because it had the superior force. Please note that a ruling that
the English and Italian separate attacks stood off the French double
attack would have meant that two independent moves constitute a
support. I can not accept this. In real life, things would happen
as separate engagements, not simultaneously. I rule that the French
fight off both siggle attacks AS SINGLE ATTACKS, 2-1 both times.

If anyone can justify any other ruling on either of the above they are welcome to try. However, to do so would mean, in the first points throwing the rulebook out, and, in the second, would mean convincing me that move orders constitute supporting factors under certain conditions, something I am not yet ready to accept.
