THE GILLILAND DUESTION

A number of responses (although, curiously, nothing from Alexis himself) to the editorial discussion last time. Von Metzke says "I have two reactions: (1) You're Wrong; (2) You're right." Reinsel states that the problem has caused him sleepless nights without a real decision. Richard Shagrin argues, along with Don Miller, that the English F Denmark was destroyed but neither side moved in. I can't find ANY grounds for that. With Von Metzke's or my own viewpoint, we are interpreting the rules as we see them -- sort of reasing between the lines and applying logic to what we see. However, the argument that the thing is destroyed (and one player suggested that the center then becomes a neutral again) is in the nature of a new rule, not an interpretation, and I can't accept it. Valid points can be made both for my ruling (which I see as the most logical -- naturally) and those on Gilliland's side (which I see as illogical but legal). So Conrad's correct -- I'm wrong and I'm right -- but, in a sense, he's incorrect. Like the proverbial baseball umpire, the Gamesmaster may make errors in judgment but he's always right.

One person did complain that I should have made it clear which way I would rule before the game began. This is patently ridiculous -- I could not be expected to forsee it, although now that it's come up I think you all know my ruling.

Another nice little problem comes up which has at its heart the

same interpretational problems but in reverse:

Italy obviously made an error, but what happens. Does the Italian support for the Turkish move mean Turkey gets into the Ionian? Or Is the Italian support an invalid order, cancelling out the move, and thus making it a 1-1 standoff? In real life the Turkish unit would make it, and there have been cases where, through mixups, such things have happened in warfare. But who wind? Does the rule stating that no unit may dislodge its own unit apply? I would have to rule that it does, that it's a standoff, since the Italian player is offering a support against the moves of another of his own units. I think they cancel themselves out. What do you think?

By the way -- on the Gilliland question many people asked what about if that were a 3rd power's unit in Denmark. It wasn't, so the analogy doesn't apply. But I'll discuss that point next time.
