John Boardman is attempting to systemize Postal, and he has compiled a directory of all postal diplomacy games. On his scale we are 1965R (A), 1965S (B), 1965T (C). Boardman classification will be listed along with the magazine system. He has also published a set of standard rules to straight and team postal; these rules differ from BARAD-DUR in several ways; they are more liberal in spots (allow conditional moves, blanket phone moves, etc.) and stricter in others (date of receipt deadlines, etc.). The rules used in A and B games here will be followed in C and D, unless the D players elect otherwise.

News item from paris:

FRANCE DECLARES WAR ON GERMANY AND AUSTRIA!!!

King Charles I of France and Spain announced that a permanent alliance has been made with England and Portugal.

Memo from France to Italy: Munich is mine, boy! You get Austria and I get Germany, O.K.?

Constantinople, May 18, (Reuters)

Turkish units were launched into action today as Turkey shifts her might for the war against Austria. This follows close on the heels of the settlement of the Islamic question in Sevastopol and the subsequent Russo-Turkish peace pact.

Although hopelessly outnumbered, the Royal Islamic Bulgars continue their unceasing attack on Greece, a long-contested prize which Turkey claims historically, and which Austria claims because it's there.

Rumors of the Austro-Italian agreement over the Trieste controversy have not disturbed the Sultan. "The Unholy Alliance is still firm," he announced yesterday.

Dateline: Moscow

The Grand Russian Fleet which was vacationing in Rumania for the winter has returned to its base at Sevastopol. Czar Millerinski wishes to advise all Nations that Rumania is now free - under the military protection of the Russian Empire - and advises both Austria-Hungary and Turkey to keep "Hands Off!"

Because of the sad state of affairs of the civil government in Germany, the people of Berlin have asked the Russian army on maneuvers in Silesia to enter the city and help maintain law and order until the German armies return from the field and assume the responsibility. The Czar is most willing to do so, and to help our brothers in Germany, in any other way possible, to prevent further bloodshed and rioting in the strife-torn German cities.

A letter received by Mssr. Maximus Bounder for open Publication:

From: His Imperial Highness Emperor Franz Josef von Hapsburg-Lorraine,  
Emperor of Austria-Hungary, Holy Roman Emperor, etc.

To: His Imperial Majesty, Cola III, King of the Italians and heir to the  
Caesars.

I am pleased that you accepted the title we graciously bestowed upon you as prince of Dalmatia. The Austrians accept all people as friends and equals, not to be looked down upon because of race, creed, religion, or national origin. Our two great countries must not waste themselves in useless warfare with each other, but be free to deal with more oppressing enemies. Together we could even wield a sword of peace in the war-torn Balkans and be recognized as lovers of peace and not war-mongering monarchs.

## Game A Propaganda, Continued:

From Der Abend Stern (Reuters), Vienna, April 22, 1902

## Editorial:

The Turkish Hordes are again threatening the mainland of Europe. Austria and her Brave ally Russia have been doing their most to contain this vile threat from the South. All Europe remembers how the Moslems oppressed and Killed the Christians in the past, and reports filtering in from Bulgaria say that atrocities are being committed ~~\$\$\$~~ even now, in the twentieth century. To answer this threat, Austria asks for a year of general peace between Austria and Russia and all who may be presently attacking them, so that we, (Aus. and Rus.) may answer this threat to the safety of all Christendom.

From: Der Wiener Sonne (AP), April 29, 1902.

The Heir-apparent, Francis Ferdinand, has accepted an offer to visit Sarajevo in 1914, when their new City Hall will be finished. The Archduke, is not unwise in accepting such a long term invitation, since he is in the prime of life and will certainly be almost as healthy 13 years from now.

Rome, March 26, 1902

Dear Sir;

As you know, due to unforeseen circumstances, the war between Italy and Austria-Hungary has been resumed.

The Sultan of Turkey has sent to his Majesty, Victor Emmanuel II his condolences and the Gallant offer of Turkish aid in Italy's war with the treacherous Austrians. Enclosed clippings from prominent Italian newspapers will tell the rest of this story.

From the Naples Royalissimo:

COLA III ASSASSINATED!" PRINCE ROYAL MURDERED!

Rome, Dec. 28, 1901. His Majesty Cola II, King of Italy was assassinated today on his way back to Rome.

The Brutal murder was committed by the placing of a bomb under the Royal train on its way home from the winter capital at Naples.

Seven are being held as suspects in the plot. Certain sources have disclosed that two of the men held are known Austrian agents.

Rome, Dec. 28, 1901:

Word has been received in the Capital of the death of Prince-Royal Umberto, killed when his ship was sunk by Austrian gunfire during the Winter maneuvers in Albania. Further Word is expected.

From the Rome Newspaper, L'Observatore:

AUSTRIANS MURDER COLA III, COUNT VON BRECHTHOLD BOASTS OF MURDER!

Vienna, Dec 29, 1901: Emperor Franz Josef today made Count Otto von Brechthold the new prince of Dalmatia.

In a speech before his court, the senile old Emperor reviled the memory of Cola III, calling him "That war-mongering imperialist!"

In his first speech before the court as prince of Dalmatia, von Brechthold actually boasted of the successful plot to murder the "troublesome king of Italy and his son, and therefore put that kingdom into confusion.

Also from L'Observatore:

KING VICTOR EMMANUEL II MAKES SPEECH BEFORE CHEERING PARLIAMENT:

His majesties speech read as follows:

"The treachery of the Austrians has cost us a father and a brother, therefore wish Austria to be destroyed." "We now claim, through my ancestors, the right to upon the throne of Austria, and we also claim the throne of Hungary as Our Own."

The Russian army Budapest cannot retreat into an occupied or contested area, and is eliminated. The Russian Fleet Rumania failed to dislodge Turkish fleet Black Sea, the convoy stand-support stands, and Russian Fleet Rumania, which cannot retreat into occupied Black Sea, Bulgaria, or Sevastopol, is also eliminated.

The English army Norway is eliminated, since there can be no convoy-retreat and all adjoining land areas are occupied, with the exception of Finland, which is the point of origin of the attacker, and no swaps are allowed.

MEMO: April 18, 1902.

FROM: The crass, bovine, inept, loathsomely homely, weak, ineffectual, jejune (I am!), unprolific, maiden-loving, deplorable, Heinieous, gangrenous, lumpy Emperor of Austria-Hungary, Franz Even:  
 TO: The thickwitted czar of All the Russias, Ulbert the Unclean.  
 GREETINGS, SUCKER!

The Sultan of Turkey, Mohammed Ali Donlad, demands an apology from the President of Switzerland for the misspelling of his name in the note published in BARAD-DUR 4. It is Sultan Mohammed Ali Donlad -- not Donald! Also, we wish to remind the President that the direction of Mecca from Constantinople depends upon your point of view -- it can be either east or west -- the fact that the President views the direction as east is a commentary on the short-sightedness of the typical Western nonbeliever -- we, in Turkey, take the long view in our worship of Allah, as we do in everything else.

MEMO FROM THE PRESIDENT OF SWITZERLAND TO THE SULTAN OF TURKEY:  
 Switzerland, being a peaceful neutral, humbly apologizes to the Sultan for not reading his mind; the name is Donald on the original propaganda except for the signature, which we missed. So you never heard of a Romansch accent?

Paris, March 1 (UPI). In the Estates-General yesterday the Emperor of France bitterly attacked the foreign armies present on his borders. "Only when the treacherous Italians have withdrawn from Piedmont can there be peace between our nations," he said, and continued, "furthermore the devilish Huns must be turned back from Belgium and driven out of Holland. We cannot tolerate German forces there."

Herr von Reinsel stated today that Belgium belongs to France. Unless a note of apology arrives quickly from France for keeping us out of Belgium in winter, '01, a state of war shall exist between France and Germany! In this case, Germany and Italy shall combine to crush France! Germany asks that England allow its fleet to travel down to the coast of France.

ROYAL FRENCH INFORMATION AGENCY  
 TO: THE GOVERNMENT OF SWITZERLAND

We are very disappointed in the poor reporting of French information by the press of Switzerland. Of the news sent last time, only one small article was published. Has Switzerland suddenly established itself as the censor of European information, or does the fault lie with the fact that poor Swiss typists, working at 3 A.M. just couldn't see the rest of the news items? The government of France respectfully enters this complaint to the government of Switzerland, and hopes that a satisfactory reply will be forthcoming in the news bulletin.

MEMO FROM PRESIDENT OF SWITZERLAND TO KING OF FRANCE:

from France was printed.

From La Soire Astre (AP) April 24, 1902. The Commander in Chief of French armed forces Napoleon D'Isole has returned from Moscow where he discussed affairs in Central and Northeastern Europe with the Czar and Field Marshalls Kyla Iuriakin and Ivan S. Skivar. Much was said about Germany and Austria-Hungary, and discussion also touched on the rest of the European powers.

From La Providence (Marseilles paper). Havas, April 28, 1902. The Emperor's son has again been located. He is commuting between his villa in Monaco and a villa in San Remo in Italy. Treason or woman?

From La Soire Astre (AP) April 29, 1902. A stray shell from one of the battleships presently stationed in Marseilles struck and destroyed the offices of La Prvince last night, killing the editor, Raul a L'aise. Our regrets.

C Jul. Caes. Aug. Mebannicus, Imp., etc., Senato Romano: Opus, patres conscripti, est urbis Romae orbem terrarum regere iterum. Tum catervae barbarae classibus nostris ex Iberia repellendae sunt, Tum Gallia Transalpina legionibus nostris pacanda est. Europa hodie -- cras Sevagrammus!

TRANSLATION: Emp. to the Roman Senate: Conscript fathers, it is necessary for Rome to rule the world once more. Not only must the barbarian hordes be thrown back from Iberia by our fleets, but also France must be pacified by our legions. Europe today - tomorrow the Sevagram!

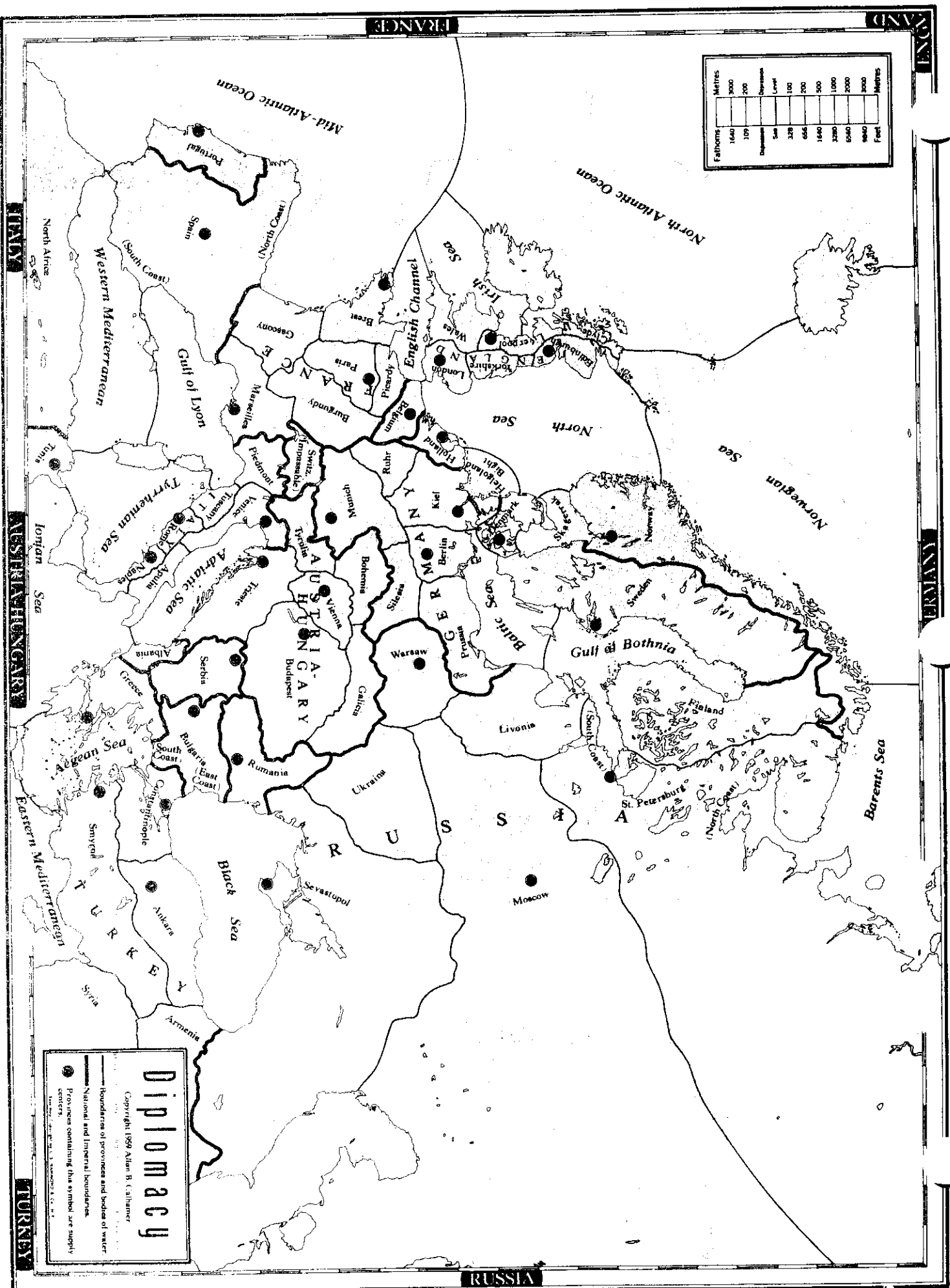
