It simply means that instead of having a Thursday postmark deadline, you simply must guarantee the move in the Gamesmasters hands by 6 P.M. Saturday of the deadline. We were the only ones on postmark, and it confused us and troubled us no end. I'm doing this on Monday at 10:30, and still have it all to run, plus I have to arise early tomorrow as usual. Late deadlines, and extreme inconvenience. If I'd had mundane work to do this evening, this wouldn't have gone out until Wednesday! Intolerable. So, date of receipt. This way we can always get all copies out on a weekend, and in the mail not later than the 6 P,M. Sunday pickup. The Austrian Government announced that all ties with Italy have been severed since the assissination (sic) on Sept, 3 of the beloved Emeror Franz Josef. The six murderers have all been caught and summarily hanged. Before their execution, three of the culprits confessed that they were Italian agents, undern the orders of Pope Aluliaportatus. The reason for their deed was probably due to the fact that the Hapsburgs recently became Lutherans, after an appeal to the Pope and Italian King to call off the Istalian Armies so that Austria might better fight the Turkish Hordes now threatening Europe. This appeal was scornfully denied. Let it Now be Known, that this so-called "Holy Empire" of Italy is in League with the vicious moslem Hordes of the East and are plootting to cut Europe's throat and share the Bloody feast. All countries are beseached to call off any ties or alliances with this disloyal and untrustworthy country of Italy.

In this announcement was also revealed a hitherto onknown attempt on the life of Francis Ferdinand, now Emperor of Austria-Hungary. The Palace guards and Francis himself valiantly defended the attempt (Involving some 30 agents), the Emperor personally killing one of the would-be assassins. The Russian Army Sevastopol must retreat to Moscow or Armenia. He should enclose this as his winter, 1902 move order. Players building in the winter should bear this in mind. A detailed survey of supply centers held at the beginning of winter (a harsher one than last year's) and directions as to how many units to build or remove is included. Players are cautioned to remember that we follow the rule FURTHEREST PIECE FROM A SUPPLY CENTER IS ELIMINATED, FLEETS BEFORE ARMIES IF BOTH AN A AND A F ARE EQUIDISTANT. The gamesmaster will eliminate unless two pieces of equal rank (A or F) are equidistant, in which case the player must submit a REMOVE winter order or have both units eliminated. Builds, retreats, and remove winter orders may be

- submitted on post cards if space on the card permits. Here's the score:

Turkey is the big winner, Russia the big loser, with Germany and Austria shedding no tears as they prepare to launch a new unit each. At this point certain patterns are evident — the Austro-Turkish alliance has been extremely profitable for both parties, at the expense of Russia, and that last nation seems in even deeper trouble from the unlikely pair in the south next move, Italy is in a powerful position, and her nonaggression pact with Austria is reaping dividends as she drives west against france. England seems to be content wrestling the weakening Russian empire for Scandinavia, possibly in alliance with the far south putsch, biding time. Germany is static, awaiting Italian advance in french territory. Of all the countries, the skill of the French and the Russian players will need to be perfect in order to avoid collapse in 2 moves. Skillful diplomacy, however, could turn the tide in this thinly balanced alliance system.

Paris, Sept. 8. (Reuters). The Emperor, in a speech to the Estates General yesterday, exposed an unknown fact about the recent Italian attempts to move from Piedmont to Marseilles. As he scrambled off the soapbox and off into the night the Colonel waved a large white feather in the direction of the Imperial Palace.

All moves succeed. Alliance systems are already being drawn, and the lask of certain traditional alliances are already evident. This may result in an unusual game, with some quick eliminations. GERMANY (Steve Patt) paid his fee but did not submit his move in time. He will have a fall move in. The movement of Russia seems to indicate that he lost no traditionally German open supply center by the missed move, and is, indeed, following the Prussian move, in a better defensive position than he'd normally be.

players are reminded that propaganda may be used to mislead a foe, or confirm diplomacy, as well as for entertainment. For your information, I wish to reprint parts of a letter accompanying the 1901 RUSSIA move; this is straight, and you can be thinking of arguments in the next 10 days:

"You may refer to...propaganda...but it all looks rather childish to me. I doubt I'll have time to do more than take moves as they come. I have a very demanding calc teacher this term.... As for the Games—master, I don't see what you would gain by any tricks. Frankly, I don't care. I'm bound to lose since I've no experience in playing. Even less in the dickering end of the deal.... Just for information, could I send revisions of moves if I get them in before deadline?...."

GAMESMASTER'S REPLY: Firstoff, your move is your final one. Only 1 chance allowed, no revisions of anything, although you can add let's say, propaganda...well...mr.... Anyway, old hands at the game, you'll note, do use propaganda, and it is always worthwhile, no matter how goofy it gets, to read it, because it sometimes contains (the not always) valuable information on diplomacy being carried out. False propaganda is here, too, but you have to weed it out. False propaganda is a tool of a 3rd party to break an alliance. In 2 different games the false propaganda has served me well. ## Gamesmasters are a special type. You can not lie to a Gamesmaster, and he can not lie to you. He can not play tricks. He is completely impartial. He is also honor-bound not to discuss any questions from players which have a bearing on the real game, except in private.#I understand your heavy schedule -- I have a heavy one, too. ## I printed the excerpts to clarify certain questions that may plague other players. We have, aside from Brooks, 2 other first-timer Diplomaniacs, and another unfamiliar to Postal tho a veteran across-the-board player. So you'll know, the ones with Postal experience are: Jacks, Huff, and Mebane. The one who's experienced across-the-board is Gilliland. Newcomers are: Brooks, Patt, Hendin.

To Germany we re-affirm the policy of Volk...Deutsch, Ein Reich, in an international sense. We wish Austria-Hungary to be known as the Dove of the East. One word of warning, however: this dove has claws!

The Sublime Porte has released the following statement by the Sultan of Turkey, Sbdul M'Banid: "The whole world knows my devotion to peace. Nevertheless, I have had to abandom the pursuit of my pacific goal within the Seraglio, even during the Holy Month of Ramadan, in order to lead my Janizaries in Jehad against the infidels of Bulgaria.Let the nations of Europe take warning that any further persecution of the Followers of the Prophet such as took place in Bulgaria will result in similar reprisals."

Edward, Duke of Saxe-Cobwig, spoke to the Belgian Parliament on April 1, and declared Ebgland's eternal friendship for the Belgian people.

Washingtom, March 1, 1901 (AP). Observers here feel the U.S. will remain neutral if war breaks out in Europe but many high ranking officials express support for economic sanctions to be taken against Britain and Italy.

Hanoi, March 5, (UPI). Discussions are underway between French, Japan-ese, and Portuguese representatives concerning British aggression along the Burmese-Indo-Chinese border, and the British naval blockade of Macao and Kyangchowwan. Observers feel a strong French, Japanese-Portuguese alliance in the offering.

Brazzaville, March 9 (UPI). Spanish, German, Belgian, and French office ials sent a message to British officials warning united action against Britain or Italy should they start aggression in Africa.

Brazzaville, March 11 (UPI). Anglo-Italian armies from Eritria and British Somoliland today attacked French Somoliland! Paris, March 2D (UPI). French troops began mobilisation today along the Belgian and Spanish borders.

May 20, 1901. Whitehall. Lord Gilliland became Prime Minister of a coalition government at 3:45 A.M. His first official act was to receive the French ambassador at 4 A.M. That afternoon he described the talks as "Very Frank," but "Correct." The French ambassador refused to speak with newsmen as he returned to consult with his government.
