1. RON BOUNDS HAS MOVED, and his new address, effective immediately, is 649 N. PACA STREET, BALTIMORE, MARYLAND, 21201.

2. Steve Patt has resigned from C and has been replaced (see intro to C game). Replacement of Steve Barr in A is still pending, but we have a replacement ready.

3. Charles Reinsel is very mad, as he should be, about certain items in BARAD-DUR. He objects to certain rulings in the last issue. All players should recognize that the auxillary rules for games are ever developing, and if you see something you think is bad, squawk & argue, and you may be winning your argument. Mr. Reinsel won his, and the following rule is now in effect: In the case of a removal, with 2 identical units equidistantly far from a home supply center, the player is expected to write a removal order. If he does not, the Gamesmaster will flip a coin and remove one arbitrarily. Ditto 3 equidistant.

4. Charles goes on to note that in #4 we said he lived 150 miles closer than he does. The Gamesmasters hereby beg his pardon, and want to know whether or not he would prefer air mail service on BARAD-DUR, on the usual condition that moves also be sent via air mail. If this would help, we'll do it. If you don't think it'll help, keep costs down O.K.?

5. Winter & summer orders are moves, just as any other.

6. THEORETICAL DIPLOMACY DEPT. Q. Can a F in the Mid-Atlantic move to Spain, S.C.? A. Yes, it borders. #Q. Could F. Gascony support F. Western Mediterranean to Spain? A. Strangely enough, yes, since a unit bordering on a country is assumed to have firepower over the entire country. # Q. Then, could F. Spain (N.C.) move to F. Spain (S.C.)? A. No. Portugal or Mid-Atlantic intervene. It is an oddity of the game. Q. Can F. Sweden move to Norway directly? A. Another oddity. Yes. There is no East and West coast to Sweden. The boundary is considered continuous for fleets. Thus, you can have a series of moves by which F Gulf of Bothnia to Sweden, F Sweden to the Skagerrak!

7. REPLACEMENT PLAYERS. C has a replacement player just assuming command; Don Miller is now #1 on the C replacement list. A & B replacement players are needed. Unless the country is in a commanding position or it's still 1901, the replacement is free.

ONLY THOSE NATIONS WHO ACT ON THE WINTER MOVE ARE COVERED. A mistake in the last issue stated that Austria, not Russia, was able to build. The Russian protest pointed out that Russia was in Budapest in the fall of 1901 and there was no unit there in the fall of 1902, so that it was still Russian property even if surrounded by the enemy. This is correct, and Russia builds 1. All 8 players were notified same-day; all other readers please make the correction.

RUSSIA.....BUILDS ARMY MOSCOW

GERMANY.....BUILDS ARMY KIEL
TURKEY.....BUILDS ARMY CONSTANTINOPLE

DEADLINE FOR THE SPRING, 1903 MOVE ORDER IS SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 1965, AT 6 P.M. EASTERN STANDARD TIME. MOVE ORDERS NOT IN THE GAMESMASTER'S HANDS BY THAT DATE AND TIME WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED, WITH NO EXCUSES ALLOWED. Future deadlines will be Dec. 4, 18, Jan. 2 (Sun.), 15, 29. The one Sun. deadline allows for New Years Day, all others are Saturday, 6 P.M. E.S.T. That for all you long-range strategists.

DISPATCHES

All players of B are requested to vote on 2 proposals made by members of the game. Send in YES or NO with your spring move. One NAY vote and the proposal is defeated, because of the nature of the 2 questions. Please consider carefully! Neither makes any difference to the Gamesmaster.

1. That the Gamesmaster, upon written request to do so by each player, call players whose moves are not in at 6 P.M. Sat. collect
2. That the spring and fall moves be the only two possible moves, by combining winter builds and retreats with the spring move (said move to be made blind of retreats or builds, since they're done simultaneously) and summer retreats being combined as 1 move with the winter move.

Some Postal games play #2, some don't. Proposal #1 is dubious, and the Gamesmaster will reserve the right to forget to do it if passed if such occurs. I can't be absolutely responsible for making those calls -- I'm out often on Saturdays.

BREAKDOWN BY NATION AT THE END OF THE FALL, 1901 MOVE:

ENGLAND controls the following supply centers: Liverpool, London, Edinburgh, Norway, and Belgium. She has units in Norway, The North Sea, and Belgium. ENGLAND MAY BUILD 2 UNITS IN Edinburgh, London, or in Liverpool.

FRANCE controls the following supply centers: Brest, Paris, Marseilles, Spain, and Portugal. She has units in Burgundy, Spain, and Portugal. FRANCE MAY BUILD 2 UNITS in Paris, Brest, or Marseilles.

GERMANY controls the following supply centers: Kiel, Munich, Berlin, and Denmark. She has units in Rhur, Denmark, and Berlin. GERMANY MAY BUILD 1 UNIT in either Kiel or Munich.

ITALY controls the following supply centers: Rome, Venice, Naples, and Tunis. She has units in Venice, Piedmont, and Tunis. ITALY MAY BUILD 1 UNIT in Naples or Rome.

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY controls the following supply centers: Budapest, Trieste, Vienna, Serbia, and Greece. She has units in Budapest, Serbia, and in Greece. AUSTRIA-HUNGARY MAY BUILD TWO UNITS, in Vienna and in Trieste. She must still submit a move/build order for winter or she can not build, despite lack of choice.

TURKEY controls the following supply centers: Bulgaria, Constantinople, Ankara, Smyrna. She has units in Bulgaria, Ankara, and Constantinople. TURKEY MAY BUILD 1 UNIT in Smyrna. She must still submit a written winter order or she does not build, despite lack of choice.

RUSSIA controls the following supply centers: Moscow, Warsaw, Rumania, Sevastopol, St. Petersburg. She has units in Finland, Rumania, Prussia, and Sevastopol. RUSSIA MAY BUILD 1 UNIT, in St. Petersburg, Warsaw, or Moscow.

THE DEADLINE FOR WINTER, 1901 BUILD ORDERS TO BE IN THE HANDS OF THE GAMESMASTER IS SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 1965, AT 6 P.M. Eastern Standard Time.

MEMBERS/PLAYERS ARE ALSO REQUESTED TO VOTE ON THE FOLLOWING QUESTION WITH THEIR WINTER MOVE. It has been suggested by a player, and requires unanimous approval of all voters.

Should the gamesmaster combine winter moves with spring, and summer moves with winter? This would mean you'd build/retreat and move on the same sheet. Some Postal games do this, others do not. It is up to you. It speeds the game (see B for an example)- an example of how separate builds/retreats slows things down, that is) but hampers you in that you move blind of the knowledge of builds and retreats. If you want it, say so with your winter build. One Nay and we stay as is.

Vienna, Sept. 1 (Reuters).
