Throughout history Vikings have been known as great warriors. "The ferocity of the Viking raiders terrified the people of Europe. Not only were they cruel, but, they also carried out their raids with zest and efficiency" said one history source. Yet there is at least one instance in history where the Vikings did not live up to their reputation as great warriors.

The time is 1006 and the place is a Viking camp somewhere on the eastern coast of Canada. They have just wiped out a group of Skraelings (natives of North America, now extinct) who's peaceful intentions were confused to be warlike and the Norse expect a counterattack by the Skraelings.

According to the Sagas nothing happened for three weeks, at the end of which time the guard came running into camp to report that a group off Skraeling boats were approaching. The Norse assumed that the natives had warlike intentions and prepared for battle. The Viking plan was to post ten men to act as bait for the approaching Skraelings while the remainder of the warriors would hide in the woods to surprise the natives.

The Skraelings beached their boats and the Norse attacked according to plan. The natives were probably paralyzed by surprise, since they did not know about the massacre of the other group of Skraelings and had come in peace. Recognizing their danger and since there probably was no time to escape, they reached for their sealing weapons. These weapons consisted of three types: spear throwers which enabled a man to throw a spear three times as far as with hand and arm only; slings similar to the one David supposedly slew Goliath with; and bows and arrows.

The Norse of this time disapproved of such weapons, considering them unmanly. Most of their weapons were intended for close combat. Against a people who kept their distance and hurled projectiles at the enemy the Norse armaments were almost useless. The Norse were running for their lives before they had cut down more than three or fours of the Skraelings.

The Norse Sagas attempt to justify this retreat by making a great deal of some strange bladderlike objects which came flying overhead. These are said to be supernatural weapons which even a Norseman couldn't be expected to stand up against. There seems to be a simpler explanation, however. These bladderlike objects were merely a part of the Skraeling harbooning gear used as a surface marker much as a modern fisherman would use a float. When they picked up their weapons there would have been no time to remove the bladders.

The rout of the Norse was so complete that they did not even stop to try to defend their homes and families and fled until their backs were against a cliff. Had the Skraelings had the intention of gaining vengeance they could easily have chased the Norse, pinned them against this cliff, and picked them off with their spears from a safe distance. However, they seemed to be contented to escape with their lives, and did not even bother to loot or burn the abandoned settlement.

Despite the fact that North America seemed to be an attractive country to settle the impression of the terrible capabilities of the Skraelings as fighting men probably convinced the Vikings to leave America rather than be in constant fear of revenge by these natives. This fear probably pre-

vented further Viking settlement in North America and this fear arose only because of the stupidity of the Norse in misinterpreting the intentions of the Skraelings.

The above story is based on Chapter 22 of Farley Mowat's book <u>Westviking</u>. While the best available information was used parts of it is educated guesswork by Mowat and it may not agree with other versions of this episode.
