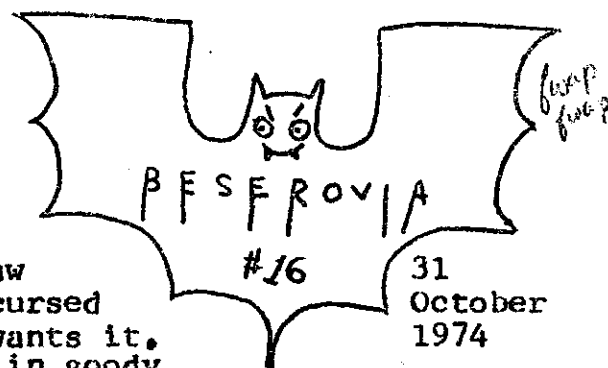

Spring 1905: Well, let's see. One player would object if I even so much as reveal vote totals, another will object if I don't bare all ...yeah. So I guess I will follow Conrad von Metzke's example. We're conducting a sort of secret ballot, I guess, but the vote totals are announced. I used to list who voted how, but that probably is a bit much. Anyway, the vote last time, officially, was 2 "no" and 4 "yes".

And Russia, again, calls for a draw. Your vote is due with the Fall 1905 orders, and if the draw is voted, it is effective Winter 1905. Again, 6 affirmative votes or abstentions are required.

AUSTRIA (Scott): A Vie-Boh S by A Trl, A Gal S RUSSIAN A War, A Boh-Sil, A Bul-Con, F Ion S ITALIAN F Tyn.

ENGLAND (Kelly): A StP-Mos S by A Lvn, F Bar-Nwy, F Bal S A Lvn, F Nth-Hol, F NAT-Mid S by F Eng, A Mun S A Sil (no English A Sil; see HR 7c).

FRANCE (Brooks): F Bre-Mid, F Mar-Lyo, F Naf S F Tun, F Lyo-Wes S by F Tun, A Bel-Hol, A Spa-Mar.

GERMANY (McKeon): A Sil S ENGLISH A Lvn-War /nso/, A Ber S ENGLISH A Mun, A Pru S A Sil.

ITALY (Blank): F Tyn H, F Rom-Nap, A Tus-Ven, A Pie H.

RUSSIA (Vagts): A Ukr, A Mos, & A Sev S A War (A Mos /d/), A War S AUSTRIAN A Boh-Sil, F Con H. (Yes, Arn, I double-checked, and you did write "A Sev S A War". Really.)

FALL 1905 ORDERS and votes on the draw are due on Wednesday, 13 November 1974.
