
Zzzzz...zzz...snurf...mumble...gurp...

AUSTRIA (Scott): A Vie\*, A Tri, A Trl, A Gal, A Sil, A Bul, F Ion (7).

ENGLAND (Kelly): A StP, A Lvn, F Bar, F Bal, F Nth, F Wes, F Eng, A Mun (8).

FRANCE (Brooks): A Par\*, F Mid, F Tus, F NAf, F Lyo, F Tun, A Nwy, A Mar (8).

GERMANY (McKeon): A Kie\*, A War, A Ber, A Pru (4).

ITALY (Blank): F Tyn, F Nap, A Yén, A Pie (3).

RUSSIA (Vagts): A Sev\*, A Mos, A Ukr, F Con (4), (1 short).
