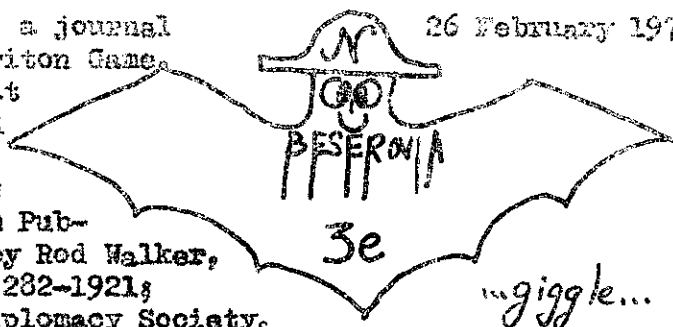

Spring 1906:

AUSTRIA (Fouquet): NO MOVE RECEIVED. A Bud /h/ /a/.

ENGLAND (Parrish): NO MOVES RECEIVED. A Gal, F Nth, F Bel, F Hol, F Pic, F Lpl /h/.

FRANCE (Baer): A Par-Bre, A Mun S ITALIAN A Ven-Tyr.

GERMANY (Hobday): A Ruh-Kie, F Den-Swe.

ITALY (Oberschulte): A Ven-Tyr, A Rom-Ven, A Mar-Gas, F Por-Spa(nc).

RUSSIA (LeMotte): A Nuy H, F Bal-Den, A Ukr-Rum S by A Sev, A Arm-Ank /a//Syr/, A Tyr-Tri S by A Vie, A Ber S ENGLISH F Hol-Kie (not so ordered)

TURKEY (Everson): A Ank-Arm S A Smy, A Tri-Bud S by A Ser & A Rum (A Rum /a/ /Bul/), F Con-Bla, F Ion-Alb, F Nap-Tyr, F Wes-Mid, F Spa(sc)-Por, F Lyo H.

FALL 1906 MOVES are due on or before 3:00pm, Wednesday, 4 March 1970.

Note: Finals and intersession take up the last two weeks in March. If anyone wishes, because of schedule problems, to delay the game during this period, let me know. Otherwise, I will assume that everyone will be here and in a position to continue play.

HOLD PRESS: I have just learned why no English moves, which reasons seems good and sufficient, so note that the moves above are amended as follows:

ENGLAND: A Gal S RUSSIAN A Ukr-Rum, F Hol-Kie, F Lpl-Iri, F Pic-Bre, F Bel-Rag, F Nth-Lon.

FRANCE: A Par-Bre.

GERMANY: A Ruh-Kie.

RUSSIA: A Ber S ENGLISH F Hol-Kie.

All other moves remain the same. Note (again): There will be no extensions of the deadline without prior consultation. Further, posted deadlines must be observed exactly; therefore, read all such announcements carefully.
