CENEVA: Reports have it that ambassadors of England and Russia have finally signed the Fifth-Third Treaty of Alliance between their two nations. Observers are hailing this achievement as a monument to the persistence of these two northern nations. As of this writing, the treaty has already been in effect for two days, which means it has outlasted 49 of the last 52 treaties. Hopes are that a record will be set.
