

GERMANY-RUSSIA MAKE BID FOR SUPREMACY AS AUSTRIA INVADED, TURKEY MENACED, ITALY THUMPED!

<u>Spring 1905:</u> No moves were received from the Italian player. The first stand-by, Eric Just, P.O. Box 131, Peoil OK 73074, is requested to make stand-by Fall 1905 moves for Italy. Copies of this issue will be sent to Eric and also to Alian Calhamer. His commentary on the moves is requested (Ai, I could use it by the Fall 1905 deadline indicated below, please).

Please also note the Turkish moves. The Turkish player

sent moves conditional upon the four directions for the italien retreet; however, he did not make any moves conditional upon the pos-sibility that there would be no retreat (which is what happened). Therefore, two units in effect received conflicting orders with no way for me to resolve them. Remember, one of the possibilities inherent in any retreat is that the player will not make it.

I also have no moves (nor Sealed Orders) for the English I am sure this is an oversight on Charles' part and will

not call for stand-by moves.
