FALL 1907 MOVES are due Friday, 11 September 1970. Players should note in the Russian moves the last instance in this 'zine of Miller's Rule. The invalidated Russian support (F Ank) was not necessary to F Sev-Bla, so that the practical consequences of the use or non-use of Miller's Rule were in this case nil.

I would like to thank Conrad vonMetake, the only player in this game who bethered to vote on the rules questions. Since I received only 9 votes out of 52 eligible, I made up my own mind, as I said I would. If any of you is displeased with my decision, I hope you will consider voting the next time I put something up for player decision (which I may not, considering the picayure response I normally get).
