
Effective now, subscriptions to BF are 50¢ per issue with a minimum sub for ten issues (=\$5.00).



SWITZERLAND: Reliable high level official sources in the Scandinavian country of islands report that an invitation has been extended to the Czar of all Russians to assist in the stabilization of its economy. No response from St. Petersburg as yet. -- Reuters, October 1905.

- (i) I know Diplomacy is just for fun, but I want to win the trophy derby. Therefore, I agree to your terms. Please do not bring the Lithuanian midgets.
- (ii) Italian? Me? I am more Irish than Italian. Anyway, it is the Iranians you really have to watch out for.
- (iii) You are Iranian! What a coincidence -- I am actually more Tranian than Italian. And Uncle Ken and I never got along anyhow.
 - (iv) Is that a yes?
- (v) Could you possibly form an alliance with Germany instead of me? (vi) By 1919 I can probably get an army over to 'help' you. Maybe I should make it five or six armies and a couple of fleets too. You have no idea how much I want to help you.

Additional notes on 1980HS "Famine"

The apring 1903 NMR for Italy was in error. His orders were actually on hand and were misplaced by the CM. A correction was sent out individually to all the players in the game. This note is for the benefit of non-Famine-players who may be following the game. The Spring 1903 orders for Italy were:

Italy (de Vries)

A TYR-Boh; A TUN suns on the beaches; F AEC (s) F Eas-Smy;
F EAS-Smy.

This forces one change in the Russian orders as follows: Russia (King) A Gal-Boh/dislodged and must retreat War, Sil or OTB.

The Summer 1903 retreat for Russia was

A Gal retreat to WAR

One complaint was voiced that no time was given for negotiations before the Russian retreat. Yes, that is true but in the standard Diplomacy rules no Diplomacy ever precedes retreats, builds or removals. This is not quite practical in postal games because negotiations cannot be entirely stopped. However, all cases where I split seasons I will provide just enough time to ensure that you can get the zine and get your orders back in. I cannot prevent negotiation, but you will probably have to do it over the phone.

One player called for an extension of the season because of my error creating a problem in negotiation after the Russian retreat. If two or more players had asked for an extension I might have considered it, but I don't want to slow a game down any more than is absolutely necessary. The Russian retreat to WAR was quite predictable and in any case, conditional

With a total of four summer retreats involved, I will call for summer 1903 orders only on Tuesday February 3rd. Deadline at 12:00 noon PST.

A question has been raised over the German order in Fall 1902 where an army in Belgium supported an army in Kiel. Belgium does not border Kiel and the support was not valid. It made absolutely no difference in the adjudications, however.

Press:

AUSTRIA to FRANCE: After your fall stay in Tunis, you're invited too!

ICELAND to LONDON: While watching from afar its clear to all that Russia has too many friends for you to be so rude.

SWITZERLAND to PARIS: Remember when we discussed the ADRIATIC SEA ACCORDS, why haven't you fulfilled your end of the bargain?

VALENCIA to PESTILENCE: I understand that Al Rodriguez is cutting way back in the postal hobby and is dropping most (all?) of his games. I tried to reach him by phone the night of the deadline but was unable to get him. If Al does indeed resign from the game, would you want him to name a replacement to take over the Cerman position? If anybody has a strong opinion about this--one way or the other--please let me know by the February 3rd deadline.
