Winter 1803: Department of correction: The Turkish move F Ion-Nap failed, of course, since there is an Italian fleet there. The Austrian fleet is mislisted in #11, whereas Fall 1802 (BLEFESCU 7) clearly show it in Apu. The Austrian orders, which did not take account of this error, were corrected on the basis of Austria's Decided Orders, which have now expired and must be replaced. Please note that there are three undislodged units in civil disorder: F Kie, F Nap, and A Rom.

Num. That means these Russian moves also failed: A Sil-Ber, A Ber-Kie, A War-Sil. That is very serious. We must therefore delay the game. We have moves from Austria, England, France, and Russia. All of you may wish to correct your moves on the basis of the revised positions. Final Fall 1803 moves are due Thursday, 23 April 1970.

Note: The abbreviation "Nor" is not acceptable for any province. Orders using "Nor" will be treated as ambiguous and will fail. The use of "Nor" in SO3 moves was a type error; the relevant Russian move was "A Fin-Nvy".

Winter 1805: Turkey's A Ven-Pie failed. The Russian moves were slightly miswritten (but not inaccurate), s/b "A Boh-Mun S by A Ber (A Ber /d/ /a/)". Russia in #10* has no removal, since a unit was /a/. Turkey builds F Smy. Current positions: ENGLAND (Keathley): A Nwy, F Nth, A Edi, A Yor, F Lon, A Hol, A Ber, F Kie, F Bal, A Bar, F Swe. FRANCE (Turner): A Mun, A Ruh, F Rom, F Wes, A Tus, F Lyc, F Rus, F Tyr. RUSSIA (Haggart): A Lva, A War, A Boh, A Sil, F Fin.
