Lou Zocchi has come out with his hundred sided die. \$5.00 for this item. It is not gem not opaque either. It is like a ping pong ball with 100 numbers on it surrounded by a plastic sphere with 100 facets on it that are right below the the facets, and it has little weight inside and that helps it come up one number like yhe round 6 sided dice. The numbers are hard to read but everyone will want a 100 sided dice.

Chaosium has rereleased the King ~~XXXXXXXX~~ Arthur Companion, to go along with the Penn-dragon game. I'm not sure if this game or book really has been changed much at all or not, but it has new cover art and it looks very good. The first one was very well done also. Chaosium puts out very good products and this is one of them.

Dark Horse miniatures has come out with the seventh set of the TMNT figures. This set ~~EEEE~~ is the ever lovable Teeror Bears. Terror Bears have great powers and are striking back at humans for experments that were done upon them, neat little monsters and and not all bad. That is the nice thing about this game the things are not black and white in fact they are often grey in this game, thus the good guys have bad things and the bad guys some good things as well. TSR has finally come out with a new novel in the Dragon Lance series. This looks to be yet another very good book. Mini Figs USA has released the 100years War and War of the Roses figures. These are 25mm and they are released. Some of these figures have appeared in a number of the lines that MF USA has done through out the years.

GHQ Has come out with their Squad Leader paks. There are Infantry and support weapons as well as tanks. The kicker is that you can buy these cheaper if you buy the paks in the regular GHQ packing, except for the above two mentioned items. Oh well they should sell quite well any way, just for the people to say I have the Squadleader figures. Time will tell.

Osprey books have come out with two new elite series of books One on the Greeks and the other one on the Israeli Forces. They have also started a new series call the ~~the combat aircraft series~~ the combat aircraft series, They have out in this series just two books the F-15 and the F/A 18. These books look very good and should be giving the Squadron books a run for their money now. The Elites are at \$9.95 and the Combat aircraft is at 7.95.

The FASA Dr Who figure have finally come out with eight sets of figures. They have just added Temporal marauders, Time Lords, Bridg. Gen and unit Troopers and the Sgt and unit troops. all of these are \$4.50.

Persian Gulf from GDW has finally made it to the stores. this one is \$24.00 and they have added some very nice features here for adding politics to this game. I would say that this one looks the best of any of them at this time. They really did a very good job with this game, the counters; the maps etc. Good job by GDW. Collect them all and keep GDW in the bus. a couple of more years, with ~~WWIII~~ Europa and WWII series they are the king of the serials.
