Heartbreaker miniatures have come out with there first 12 blists cards. They are looking really nice give them a try.


West End games have come out with Infiniverse Update book for Torg. as well as the Central Valley Gate Book For Star Wars Missions to Lianna Book an adventure.

From Balborian games Formkorn Mose for Cyberpunia a module and from Atlas grass there is related this fifther



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
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

The Road to The White House, he one of the games put out on the elections that are comming up. There have been many good games on this type of things for years. They all get dated though, if they are any good. Load to the White is not a game that will really get dated. It is fun to play and it is a good game for anyone that would like to know more about the way to run for the high Office. This game might seem a little pricy, but you are getting a lot for your money and I'm very sure that once you play this game you will play it again and again.

What do you get in this fine box for \$30.00 well you get the simple rules and then the exspanded rules. you get lots of plastic playing pieces Event cards at lrast a couple of decks worth of them, Dice, Candidates book, list all of them, cards for the candidates so that you have this right in front of you at all times. A deck of 25 issue cards and a booklet to allow you to make your own candidate and sheets to copy off so that you can keep track of all the votes that you are going to get a create. I even got a game with the Clinton, Bush, and Perot so I can play a run off of all the elections before they happen. That is not normally in the game I got that as an extra because I know the people that made this game, and I know the game's Designer. I forgot to mention the mounted map and the Plastic cury inside to hold all this stuff. You are getting your money's worth with this game it is heavy and it is filled right up to the top. Good stuff in this game.

This game is a good game in that it does some things that other games don't do. The movement is all by air and depending how type of aircaft you take you get to only certain places form certain areas. When you are in a city you roll the dice and that is the color of the airline that you will take to get some where, and they are all different. Or you can buy a first class ticket and travel to any major city you want. When you get to a place you record the vote that is in that city and place it on you state total, then when the campaigning is over it is a matter of who has the most votes in that state get the votes and you can see if you elected.

There is a simple game that is stripped down for kids and people that do not want to get into all the meat there is in this game. This game has just two pages of rules. It is quick and gives you a rough idea on the election process. Then there is the neaty game that has issues, candidates have stands on issues, you get surrageates cut there to do your work, take in money in different ways spend it in different ways etc. Various events will come up that will have different things happening to you or the election. There is a lot of thinking and a bit of lucit in this game to make it really go. With certain issues you will want to get not have and other issue you will want to bury quickly. They all only last for so hong, but they can be brought up again. There can only be so many issues on the burner at one time. You will want to be certain places when these issues are in the limelight and keep away from others. It all depends on how your candidate stands on certain issues. You can even allow you views on issues an make your self up and see if you would be elected.

There are all sorth of things that you can do with this game, that makes it so good. The one thing that I did not like is that you had to gut the stickers cuto the plastic pieces. Also the sheets to make up your candidate seem a bit complex, and the rules are some what vague in a couple of areas. Also making up your candidate will take quite some time. Don't plan on playing a game and make you your candidate in one night that will take you about 6-10 hours to do. Making the candidate is or can be a hard thing to do end then write it all up... It is fun but it will take a bit of time. What I do like about this game is that it is very open ended and you can do a lot of things that you never thought that you would be able to do. It is a good game no matter what your interest. I would suggest that you take a look at this game if you like to play games at all. Good Art, good production tall a good game. Up it.

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


