I'll be taking notes on what is coming out etc on this end.

I have one person signed up for game B-62 if you would be interested in signing up for a game the cost is \$15.00 and \$10.00 if you are in a game already in BOAST. Enough of all of this, but one final note, since I have re worked my time I'll be able to give you more indepth reviews as I will be going over more games and things more that ever before. Thus I should be able to tell you better what is out there and what is about. So on with what is new...

From Clash of Arms games there are two new games that will be appearing at Orgins. They have the Speed of Heat. This is an air War game based on AirPower etc from GDW. This game covers the early air wars inthe age of the jet fighters. This is Korea and Vietnam, and covers air to air as well as air to ground. You get a large rule book, six small maps that can join together anyway, Counters , sceaniro book, with a lot of really good information and histroy of the planes, and charts lots of charts. All of this in a beautiful box with great artwork on the cover. The Game is \$36.00 and looks to be well worth all the money that you would spend to get this one. Then They will be coming out with The War for the Union. This game looks very much like say Victory Games American Civil War game. It is not the scale is different and thoughts behind the games are different. In this game you get a large Map that is very well done. Great looks on it and it is of a very heavy card stock covers from The east to Missouri and down through Louisiana. I haven't read anything in this game yet, It was here when I came back from Boyscout camp. The Cardboard map is in one piece and cut like mounted maps. 600 counters of all sorts, three different rule books history etc are given. There are some small basic rules and then there are the advance rules which are three times as long as the basic game, thus you can do what you want with this game. At \$36.00 it is a great looking game with lots of charts as well that are given in this game. A Very Nice box tops this game off another good value at \$36.00.

BattleMaster from Milton Bradley has made its way into my home. I was playing this game over atCubi Con and it was fun to play, It is a lot like HeroQuest being very simple game rules and there is so much that you can do with this game. You have a frame work that is great to start a really good game with and continue and do more with it. The plastic pieces are really well done, though you do need to glue the pieces down or they fall off. It is better anyway since you only take three hits and you are done. Like I say change a couple of rules etc and you have a great fun game. It will be a great way to get people into games and young ones into minatures as well. Take a look at this game and you will see that it is worth the money that you will spend on it.

Then from GDW we have the Dangerous Jouneries #2 called Mythus Magic at \$24.00

Also Ral Partha has come out with the Medium Omni Mechs for the Clans. This finishes all the Clan Mechs. Except for the new ones in the 3055 book that they have come out with.

RAFM Mekton Figures looks really good as well and they can be used with BattleTech as they are the same size etc. More on all this in later issues of this zine.

BOAST is now 20 years old. Started in Sept 1971 BOAST has come out everythird week since then. Appox. 17 issues per year. There have been up and downs with this zine. Over the course of the last year or so the use of the maps has helped the GM and the players in the games. Started in Zeeland Mich in 1971 BOAST Moved to Batavia IL in 1981, and then to Detroit in 85. During the time span of 20 years only 2 issues of more than 300 came out late. Both of those were within 24 hours of the deadline. Not the best record, but one to be proud of. Well over 50 games have been completed through this zine. Almost 60 games have been started on these pages with some still going. BOAST is the working magazine. We are not pretty, we are not fancy, we just get the job done fairly quickly. Now each game has its own page to make finding the game and keeping track of the game easier. All this for \$12.00 game fee, that includes the sub, and if you start another game while you are in a game it is only \$7.50. There is a game opening now.

Why did I get this issue??? Well if you have never heard of BOAST and you have just gotten into the hobby?? Well I found your name somewhere on someones list, and I'm sending you a free sample of BOAST. Maybe you are looking for a game, I have them open, maybe you just might want to subscribe? This is a sample and do with it what you would like. It is also your invitation to come on and join in on the fun!!!

BOAST runs on very strict 3 week deadlines. The deadlines are noon on Sunday. Boast is then mailed either Sunday night or Monday morning. We like to have press in the games and I enjoy writing some of it myself. BOAST is a home town zine with a lot of friendly people and friendly reading for you.
