ERRATA: Your overworked QM just noticed Rule 36.9 which states "If the player with a FARC Monarch is successfully usurped, the FARC Monarch and the player's PC are killed." This means that both Countess Mary and Earl Michael bought it when John and Thomas (respectively) were overthrown. This means they lose their next turn, are busted down to their original rank (Baroness and Sir respectively), lose any drms, and half of their PPs and IPs. Which means they must also reduce their factions to reflect their new PP status. Which means there will be loyalty chits available for Turn 9. So, ...

- Mary's & Michael's faction reduction (actually, Turn 7)
