

OK, Scenario 3 "Struggle for Dominance (Part 2)" has been suggested, so that's what we'll do. Rather than work through complicated permutations of options, let's do it this way. You have the choice of the Basic Rules (Sections 1-7), the Advanced Rules (sections 1-11), or the Full game (all rules except Section 12, Excommunication, which wouldn't be enforceable in pbem anyway). So what I need from prospective players are a preference list of countries (for a 4-, 5-, or 6-player game) and which rule sets you want to play (Yes), will play but don't care to (Abstain), and won't play (Veto). So a fiktitious Joe Cool might answer:

4-player: F/T > M/P > V > A

5-player: F/T > V > P > R > M

6-player: V > T > P > M > F

Basic (A), Advanced (Y), Full (V)

If we can't get at least four of you to agree on a rule set, we'll punt and try again next time.

Wheel check (10 OK). Ahead 1, lash attack on Josephis' team; J evades (7+2 vs 3+2, -1 pt) from this turn. Ahead 1.

Maximus (York): 20, no whip. Ahead 2, out 1, ahead 17.



Remember, if a Prez must contribute cash to buy the train, it must be bought from the Bank, either an abandoned 4-train or a 6-train or diesel. Grey tiles are available. Small cities may be upgraded/downgraded.
