I'll play whatever form comes up next time and look forward to a new game.

**GM:** Interesting. The bidding definitely decided the outcome. My impressions in this game: James was a very good bidder (but subpar player). Mike I know to be both to be a good bidder and good player (he was the HotW w/ Bidding tourney at WBC in 1999). Kevin is a good player (although he's been known to "sandbag" early epochs in the normal game) and an average bidder. Laird Khoa bids so high for the right empires, but his play is average. David, bad bidding, average play. Wayne, horrible bidding, good player.
