game and to the conduct of the player. Among the best is the following, of British vintage:

1. Never move any piece once until you have touched every other piece twice. Touch and move is a system adopted by some players to obtain a mean advantage when they fear they have a losing game.
2. If you have a piece "en prise," immediately put another so. It may confuse your opponent.
3. Bang your pieces down when you move. It intimidates your opponent.
4. As an onlooker, make your comments audibly, and never hesitate to move the pieces on the board. It will demonstrate the clarity of your thinking and the stupidity of the players, until you see the piece that you overlooked.
5. Never resign. There is always the chance that your opponent may drop dead before he mates you.
6. Always give a check if you can; it may be mate. Anyhow, it is better to have checked and lost than never to have checked at all.
7. Stick to one opening, even if it is bad and you don't know it. One day you will find somebody who knows it less.
8. Castle, take "en passant," promote Pawns to minor pieces whenever you can. It helps to create the impression that you have a deeper knowledge of the game than you really have.
9. Never think before you move. "Move and think afterwards" is more usual. You can always retract your move, but your opponent must never be allowed to retract his.
10. If you think you can "announce" a mate, do so; your opponent may resign on the spot.
11. Be prodigal with your Pawns. They only hamper your pieces and those of your opponent.
12. When you stumble on a win, at once declare noisily that you had played for it. You may not c your opponent, but it is comforting.
