## CHEESECAKE HOUSERULES August 19th, 1980

### RULES

The 1971 rulebook will be used, except when superseded by these houserules. Any rule (from the book or these houserules) can be changed if all active players in the game and the GM agree to it. Any suspected GMing errors should be brought to the GM's attention before the next deadline. If a dispute arises over a GMing decision, and the concerned parties can't work it out, the GM and all players will abide by the decision of the CDO (Canadian Diplomacy Organization) ombudsman.

### ORDERS

Orders must include the game ID, season(s) and year(s), country, submission date, and signature. Joint orders, perpetual orders, conditional orders, codewords, contingency orders, etc. are all legal.

### DEADLINES

Deadlines will be five weeks from the date CHEESECAKE is mailed. Orders are due at the time my mail arrives on the deadline day. Orders may be telephoned but I'm not always around. Winter and Spring, and Summer and Fall orders will be combined into one playing period. The Spring and Fall orders may be made contingent upon the other players Winter and Summer retreats, removals, or builds. Retreats are combined with the subsequent season. The combined seasons will be separated, and/or deadline extensions will be given upon request, but don't get carried away.

### REPLACEMENTS

When a player NMRs, a standby will be asked to submit orders for that country. If a player NMRs twice in a row, or four times in five game years, he will be replaced, and removed from the standby list. Anyone NMRing will not be asked to submit standby orders for another game in that issue. In all games begun prior to January 1980 and in the three games from THE BEHOLDER, NMRed units may retreat. In any game begun after December 1979, any NMRed countries units which are dislodged will be disbanded. NMRs don't automatically separate seasons. Anonymous neutral orders will not be used. Replacement players can't vote on anything until they've played one season (Spring, Summer, Fall, or Winter). Standbys are chosen by rotation, and only limited by geography and the number of games they are in. Once asked to standby for a position, that person will be asked to standby for that position if ever necessary in the future if he's still eligible.

### CONCESSIONS

A concession can be voted to anyone with at least one unit left, and at any time. All draw or concession votes take precedence over the season with which they were called for. If more than one proposed draw or concession passes, all countries in each proposal will share equally in a draw. Lame ducks may not vote. When a vote to concede or draw a game is called for, anybody not voting and not NMRing is counted as a 'YES'. If a player with the deciding vote NMRs but still retains control of his country, the next season due will be delayed one deadline period during which only he may vote. A player NMRing out of his position may no longer vote. A second non-vote is a 'YES', and the final positions of all countries will be those of the previous season.

### CHEATING

Deception of the GM is not allowed and will get you thrown out of CHEESECAKE. Deception includes, but is not limited to, impersonating another player or lying. Deception of other players is fine with me, and although I can't encourage trickery, I enjoy it and will even help if possible.

### PRESS

Press releases (black, white, magenta) will be printed at the first opportunity after submission unless specified otherwise. Press may be made contingent upon variable factors.

SOLUTION TO DAVE RUE'S PUZZLE

- Step 1: Weigh 4 coins on each side.  
If both sides weigh the same, go to Step 2-A, otherwise go to Step 2-B.
- Step 2-A: Weigh 3 of the coins on the right against 3 of the unweighed coins.  
If the sides are equal, go to Step 3-D, otherwise go to Step 3-E.
- Step 2-B: Assume that the left side is the heavy side (or stand on the other side of the table). Remove 1 coin from the left side and add to the left 1 coin from the right side. Put the coin removed from the left, and 3 unweighed coins on the right.  
If the scale balances, go to Step 3-A.  
If the left is still heavier, go to Step 3-B.  
If the right is heavier, go to Step 3-C.
- Step 3-A: Weigh 2 of the 3 coins removed from the right in Step 2 against each other.  
If the scale balances, the 3rd coin removed in Step 2 is lighter than all of the others.  
If the scale doesn't balance, the lighter side coin is lighter than all of the others.
- Step 3-B: Weigh 2 of the original 3 left side coins (from Step 2) against each other.  
If the scale balances, the 3rd left side coin is heavier than any other.  
If the scale doesn't balance, the heavier side is heavier than all others.
- Step 3-C: Weigh the coin transferred from the right to the left against a normal coin.  
If it balances, the coin transferred from the left to the right is heavier than any other.  
If it doesn't balance, then it is lighter than any other.
- Step 3-D: Weigh the remaining unused coin against any other. It is either lighter or heavier than any other coin.
- Step 3-E: Weigh 2 of the left side coins against each other.  
If they balance, the 3rd left side coin is heavier or lighter depending upon what it was in Step 2.  
If they don't balance, the side which goes up or down corresponding to the left side in Step 2 is heavier or lighter.
