FROM Richard Kovalcik, Jr. (179, MIT, Room 24-007, Cambridge, MA 02139)  
Dated August 21: . . . In issue eight of CENTURION you said that "I give you my word . . . there is not one LIE in ((Doug Beyerlein's)) . . . letter." Let me show you the lies:

(1) From the bottom of page one: "For that dollar ((the TDA membership fee)) you receive exactly what a non-member gets: nothing." First, both members and non-members get things from TDA. TDA distributes articles for publication for much the same purpose as Walt Buchanan publishes DIPLOMACY WORLD: to spread information and to teach tactics. TDA is also distributing Youngstown Variant Maps free of charge to members and non-members. Why doesn't Walker or IDA distribute variant maps free of charge? After all, Walker did help develop the Youngstown Variant. Why doesn't he support it? Second, TDA members also get xeroxed articles and information from time to time. These articles are exclusively for members and are not for publication.

(2) "The services that TDA runs are geared to one thing only: making John Beshera look like the greatest guy in the hobby." If this is true why would TDA put out a rating list that didn't have John Beshere on the top? In fact, on the latest list Walt Buchanan is on the top.

(3) ". . . he ((John Beshera)) will at least offer the idea of bankrolling a potential major zine to get it to push a strongly favorable TDA line." It would be interesting to see Doug prove this. If this was said of a

The following letter is a photostat (weelllll, a copy of a photostat) done by Ron Stephens. I wrote a note to Ron saying that this would be printed (It's my property by law, Ron...). So here we go:

From Ron Stephens (not date, but postmarked 9/9; received 9/11; but probably dated sometime in July or June):

I'm getting a lot of bad press lately from Jim Diehl and Gary Behnen. While I'm not particularly worried about it, I think that it is part of an overall pattern that deserves comment because of its destructive nature.

A) Jim Diehl is at great pains to point out that in 19750cv, Paul Boeth and I are from the same city and feels that this is to my game advantage. I think his concern is somewhat hypocritical as he is in 1975GK with Gary Behnen also of Bloomington, MN; 1975EN with Gary Behnen and Don Ditter also of Minnesota, in 1975Xcv (CYV) Youngstown with Gary Behnen--all these games are in CENTURION.

B) Further, Jim Diehl used a pretty obvious ploy recently in 19750cv to elicit sympathy for his "cause". The fact that Paul Boeth may not be a responsible player and may be impossible to communicate with is not my responsibility merely because I know him and live in the same city with him. Nor does it mean that I am, therefore, Paul Boeth!

C) This brings me to the recent POICTESME controversy between Gary Behnen and GM Bruce Schlickbernd. I think it revealing of Gary Behnen and Jim Diehl's thought process (especially in light of Jim Diehl's photocopied defense of "novice" Behnen which many of you have probably received ((like me))). Is this part of a campaign to follow-up Gary Behnen's "off-the-wall" threats to "destroy" GM Schickbernd?

D) Recently a new escalation occurred in Jim Diehl and Gary Behnen's 'Get Stephens campaign.' While cross-game alliances are allowed in most game zines, I don't think they are quite cricket. However, lest I be accused of hypocrisy, I have occasionally resorted to them. The situation is that Jim Diehl declared his willingness to ally himself with a player in 1975GK if that player would break an alliance with me in 1975CS in IMPASSABLE, and attack me. The interesting aspect of this arrangement is that neither Jim Diehl or Gary Behnen (both in 1975GK) are in 1975CS game in IMPASSABLE. At this point, it becomes pretty obvious that Behnen & Diehl's motivation is petty, malicious, destructive and paranoid ((Is that a threat, Ron?)). (following the Nixonian axiom "Destroy thy enemy!").

E) Jim Diehl also attacked my presence in a novice game (1975CS IMPASSABLE). While I would really enjoy being as formidable and experienced a player as they (Diehl & Behnen) regard me, the truth is that 1975EH SPECULUM, 1975CR EXPONENT, and 1975CS IMPASSABLE are the first mail games I entered and prior to that time I had played a FTF Diplomacy with one or two others except for one game with a full seven people. In short, I am a relative novice as I've only been playing since January or February by mail. However, I don't think I play badly! A final note on this: John Boyer has been around a long time and knows who is eligible for a novice game.

Frankly speaking, I don't think that mailing this information will in anyway deter Jim Diehl and Gary Behnen from their present course. Rather, this letter is a defensive effort to get out "my side," a noble attempt to expose "bad guys" and an ignorable attempt to retaliate in some fashion.

I suppose I should be flattered at having been selected to be on Behnen and Diehl's "enemies list". However, I would have thought they could have picked more sporting game--say one of the hobby's "big guys". Perhaps, they are just practicing for the future?



RON STEPHENS LETTER, CONTINUED

At present, I have made it clear to GM's in whose zines I play that the prescence of both Behnen and Diehl would necessarily entail finding a replacement for me. Diplomacy is a hobby to be enjoyed not a substitute for reality as their behavior seems to indicate.

The next round seems to be the new Youngstown game in CENTURION in which I've asked GM Russell Fox to replace Behnen or Diehl in the game (as per his new houserule #24: no two people from the same state except California and New York,--and my written request to him not to be placed in the same game) or find a replacement for me.

In closing, I'd like to give you something to think about by quoting Haile Selassie's words to the League of Nations in 1936 following the Italian fascist invasion of his country:

"It is us today. It will be you tomorrow."

Thanks for your indulgence in reading through all this ((There's still more...))--I'd welcome your comments.

((First, point A is true. I am not positive that it was Diehl in Ocv (I'm in it) but I think so.

((Point B: Once more, I cannot dispute the truth, but there were other reasons why we thought you were Boeth. However, Boeth has proved that he is Boeth. Ok, Boeth?

((Accusations (point C) here. That should be 'thought' processes, not though. The 'photocopied defense of Behnen will probably appear next issue, due to space.

((Due you or the accused have proof that you did that? Does the one who was asked to be Diehl's ally have proof? Once more, you need proof to make the statements the truth.
