WINNERS STATEMENT (Randolph Smyth):

This game began extremely badly for me diplomatically, although I never fell below six centers after 1901. For the first four years, however, I faced a hostile Austro-Turkish alliance; the interesst of the other powers can be assessed from the fact that England, Germany, and Italy had been replaced by the end of 1903! Only an incredible string of tactical breaks saved me in the south until 1904, when the Austrian began to lose interest and France dropped out. It was at this point that Baldwin as Turkey took a laudable initiative in demilitarizing our frontier. Even while fighting each other, we had picked up a total of 15 centers from our inactive neighbours by the end of 1904, and in alliance there was no ~~xxxx~~ serious opposition to our sweep westward. By 1906, when Russell took over, the war of attrition had been won. A peaceful cleanup and a two-way draw would have resulted except for some unusually bad postal problems associated with Baldwin's new address. With the first four years in mind, I struck first; while circumstances led me to continue, I had not made up my mind to go for the win until Fall 1908, the very last season ((well, not really)). Many thanks to Baldwin for a good game, and to Russell for keeping the final stages predictable.

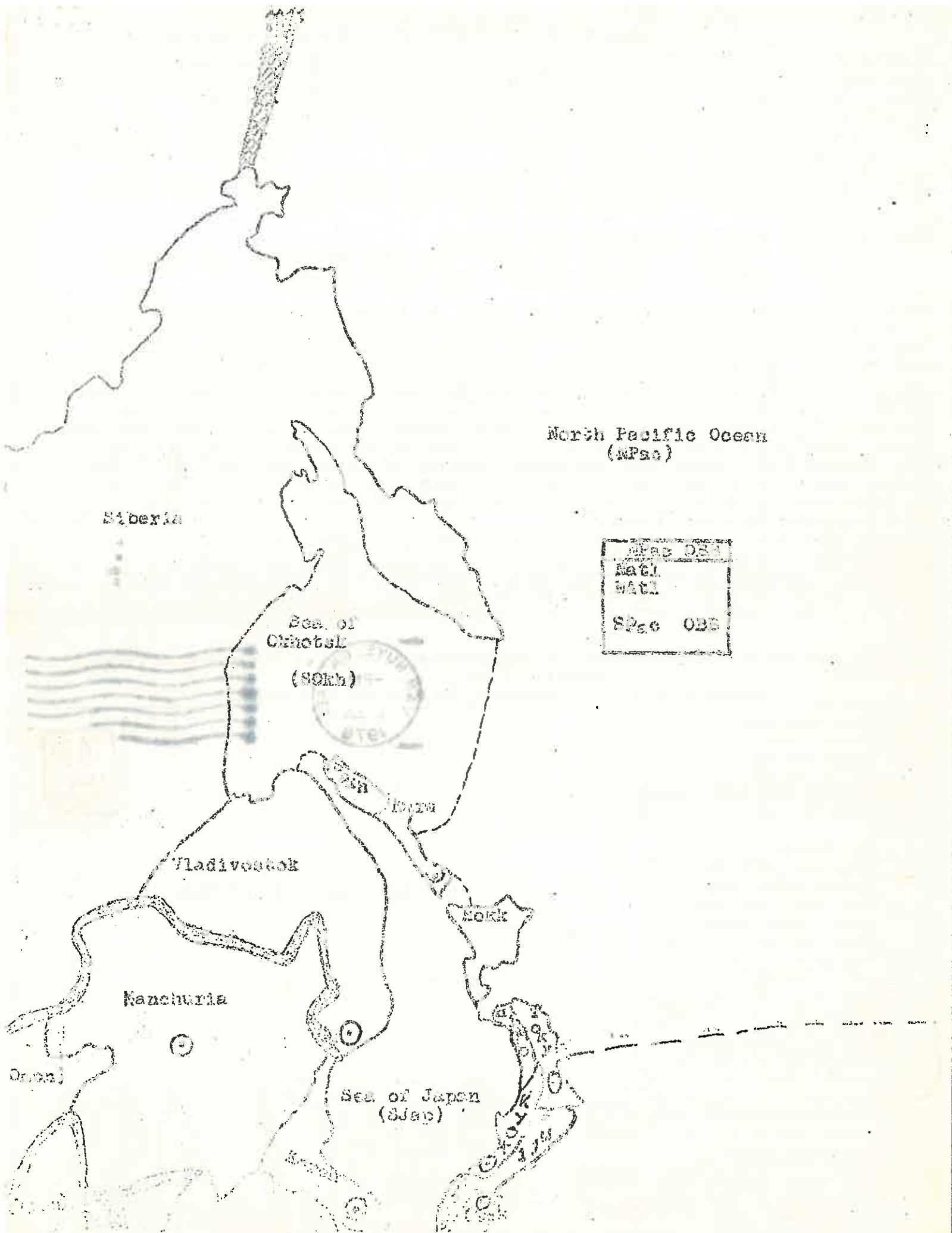

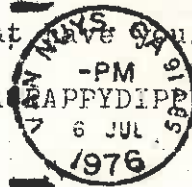

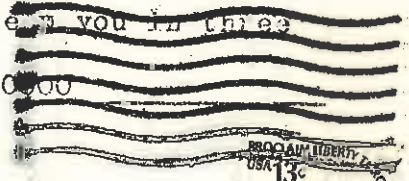
