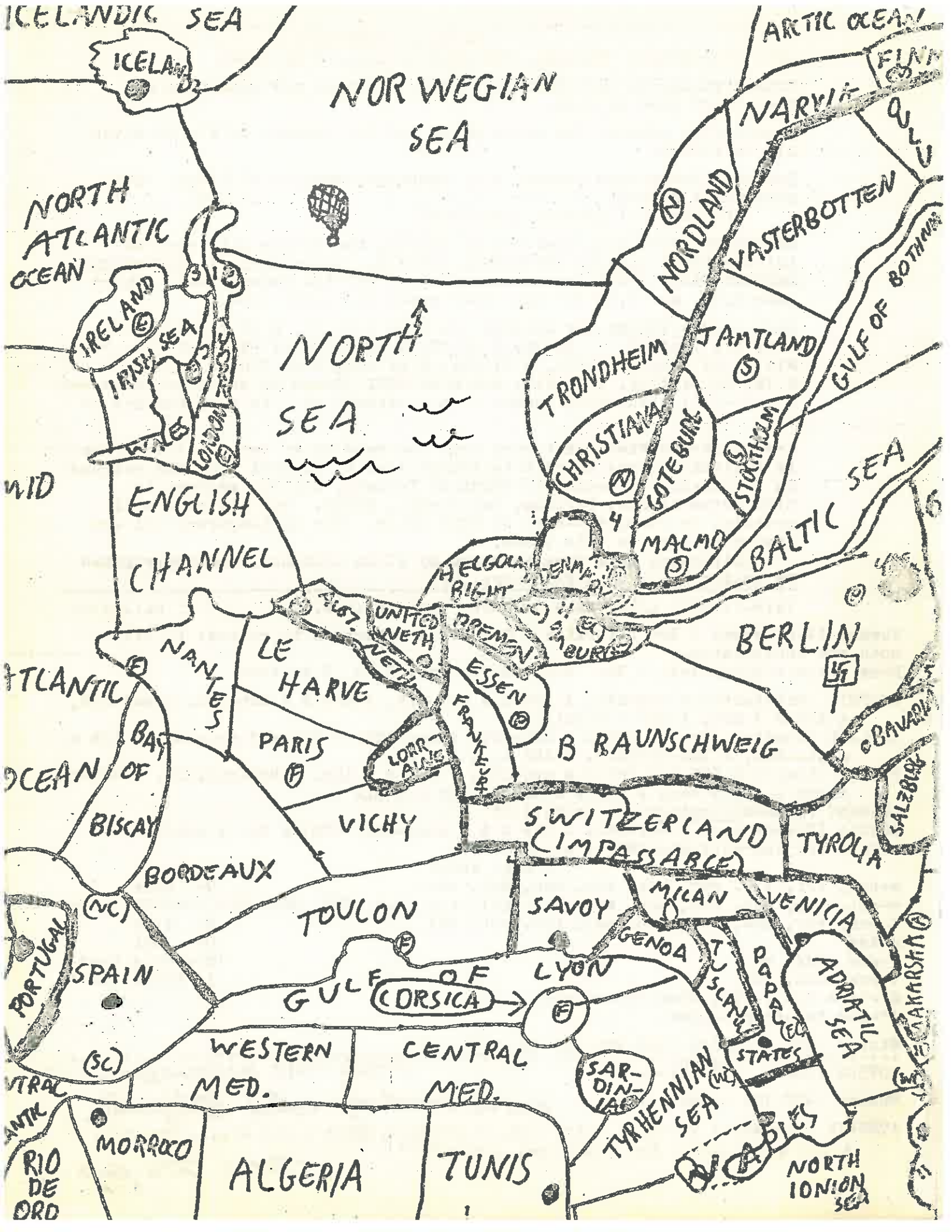

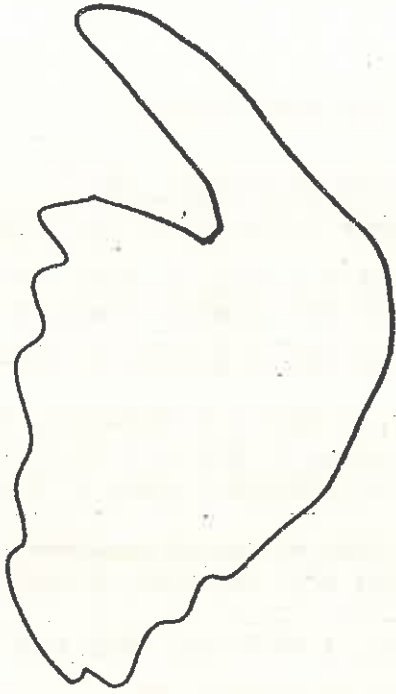

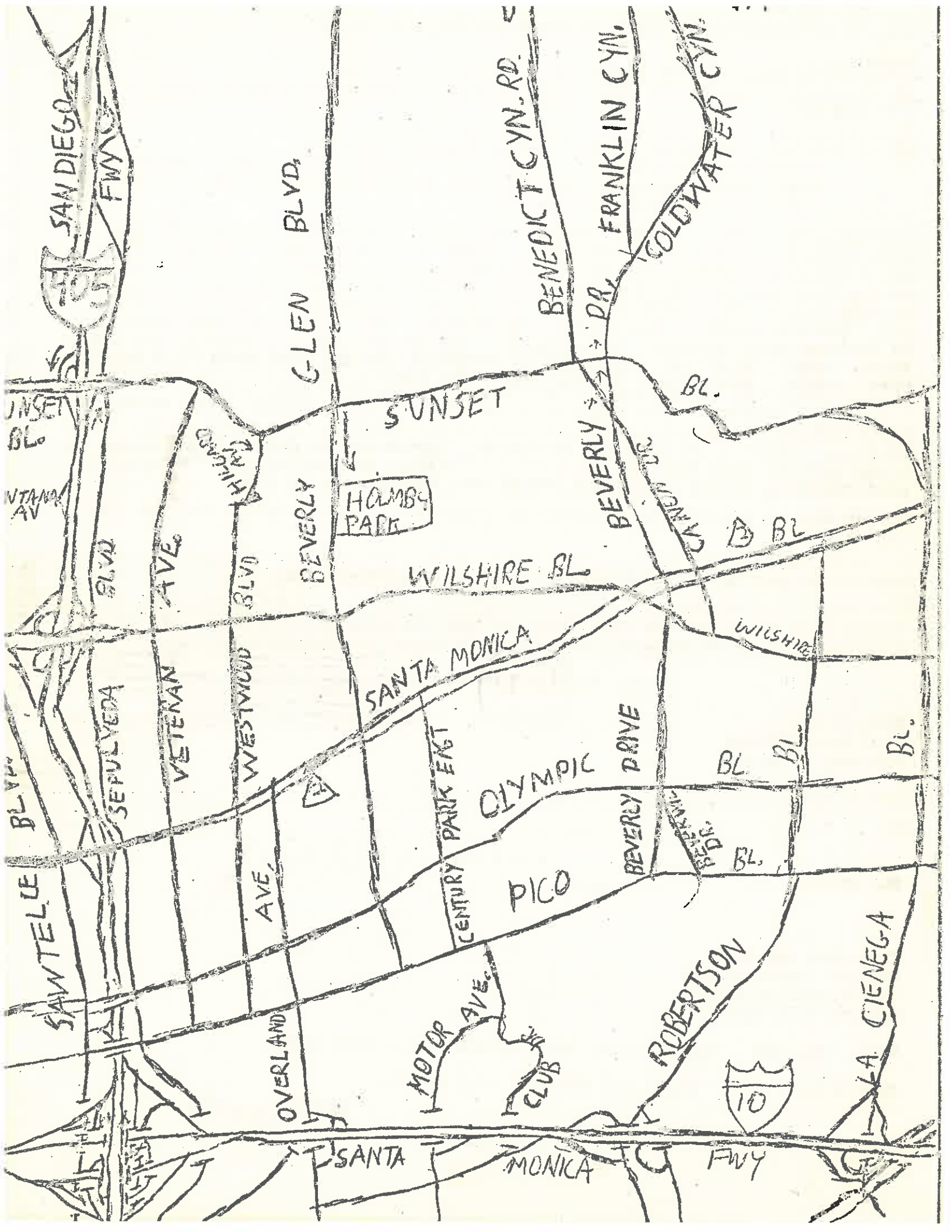

3. Forced March Rule. Because of the stupididty of the designer of this game, he has decided that the Austrians could force march there unit in Vienna. He also decided that it could only force march into Milan. That is the reason for the Circle in Milan
4. Because the Swedes are so much er, in trouble, the desinger decided to get rid of a drawback. In some of the playtest games, we noticed that Sweden got clobbered. To help out the poor Swedes, the designer decided to allow Sweden to have either F Sto or A Sto to begin the game with.
5. No one knows which option Sweden or Austria is using until the Spring 1801 orders.
6. As you may have guessed, this game begins in Spring 1801. The seasons are the same as in regular diplomacy.
7. Greece is a "colonia" type SC. Whoever owns Greece may build in it.
8. As one can easilly see, there is no Russian center bordering the Black sea. Because if the designer had not built the Volga-Don Canal, there would be a serious disadvantage to Russia, he built the ~~XX~~ Volga-Don Canal. The VDC can be entered from Ros(ec), Ros(wc), Bla, or Cas. It is a seperate province in Rostov. Rostov does border Armenia.
