
Three last notes:

GM COMMENT, To player X who complained about his Change of orders not being used. Please note that they have been BUT, only due to the unusual circumstances surrounding this seasons p orders. In the future, It is YOUR responsibility to allow enough time to get them here. Also, would you send me your phone # Baldwin.? If I had it, I could have called you collect to get the orders.

PRESS; Naples: As press reports reached the Italian Government (one eyewitness reported that the Austrian boors had, oddly, "raped our cattle and stampeded our women") of the Austrian incursion, the following was released: "All armed units are to be engaged exclusively against Austria, untill one or the other of us is vanquished". An oppisition deputy pointed out that the Turks were at the gates, and that "a more balanced defense"-IE: defending Tunis, could prolong the Italian death throes "by 6 months or a year". The government has replied, "only Austria has decieved us, only Austria will be fought". Italian forces will be deployed in such a matter as to tie up the largest number of Austrian units, even tho this provides for more rapid Turkish expansion. Austrias neighbors are to be assured that Italian harrasment will continue untill the very end, and are urged to take advantage of this fact.
