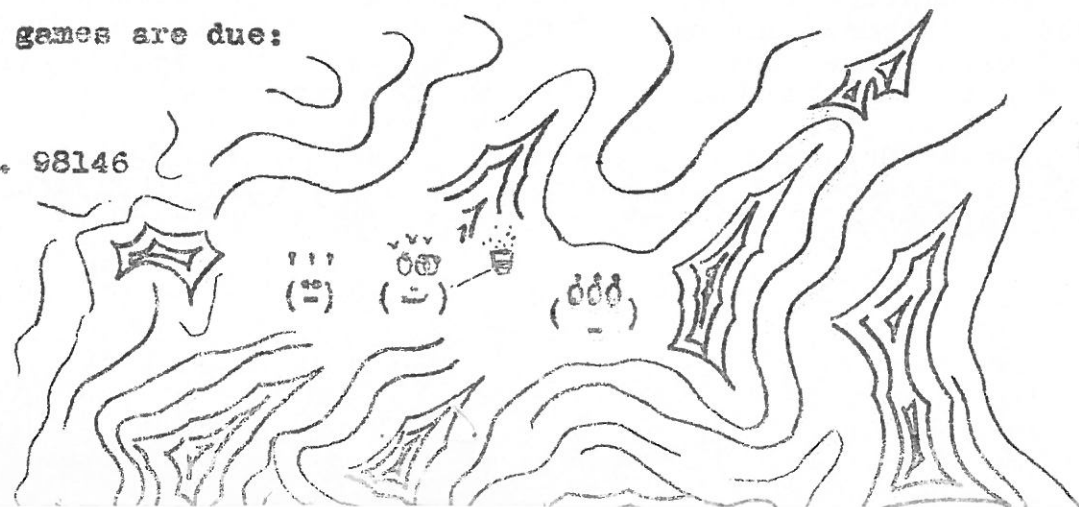

PRESS RELEASE

Roma: The King has been deposed, and General Enrico Silva has been declared Emperor.
