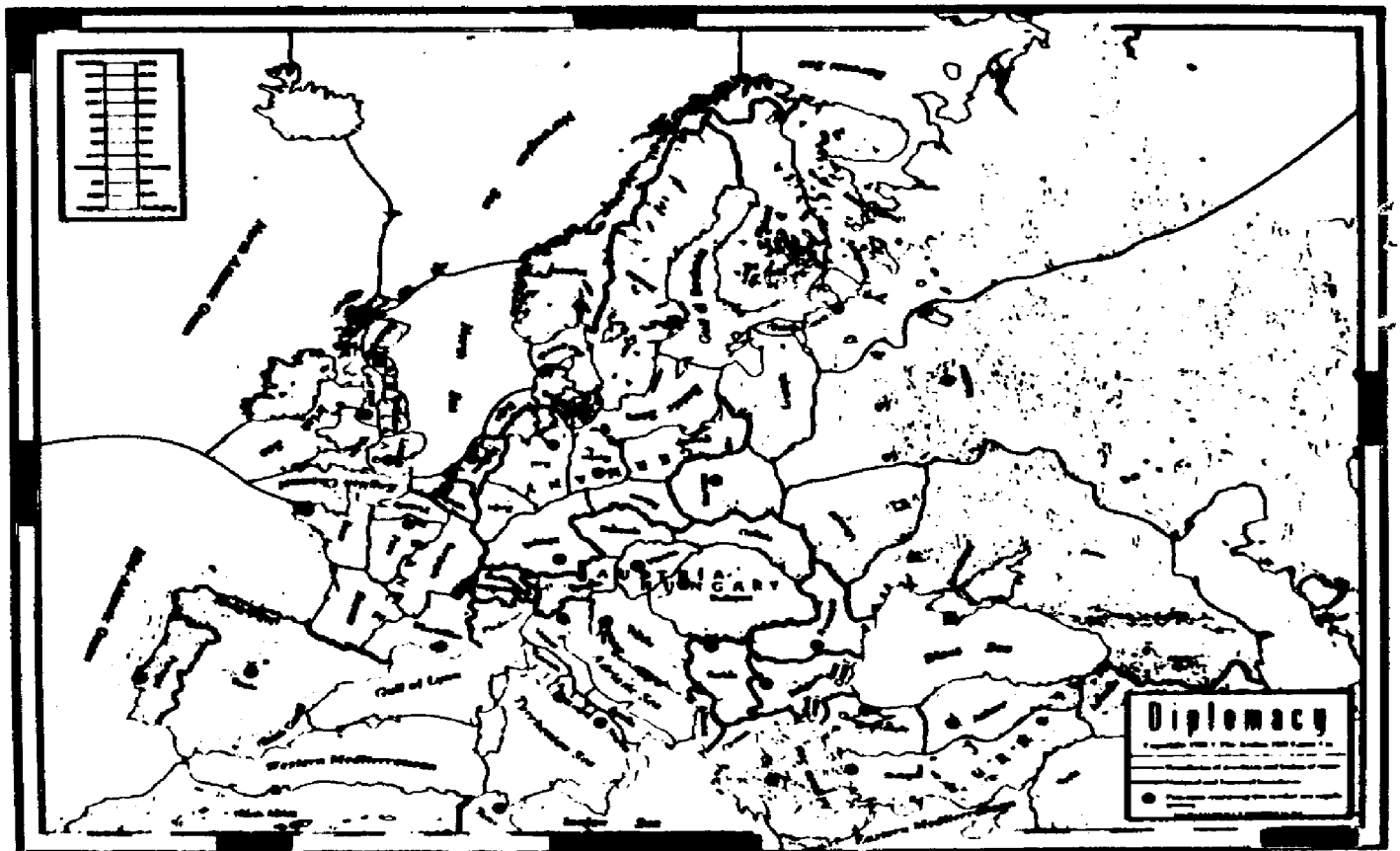

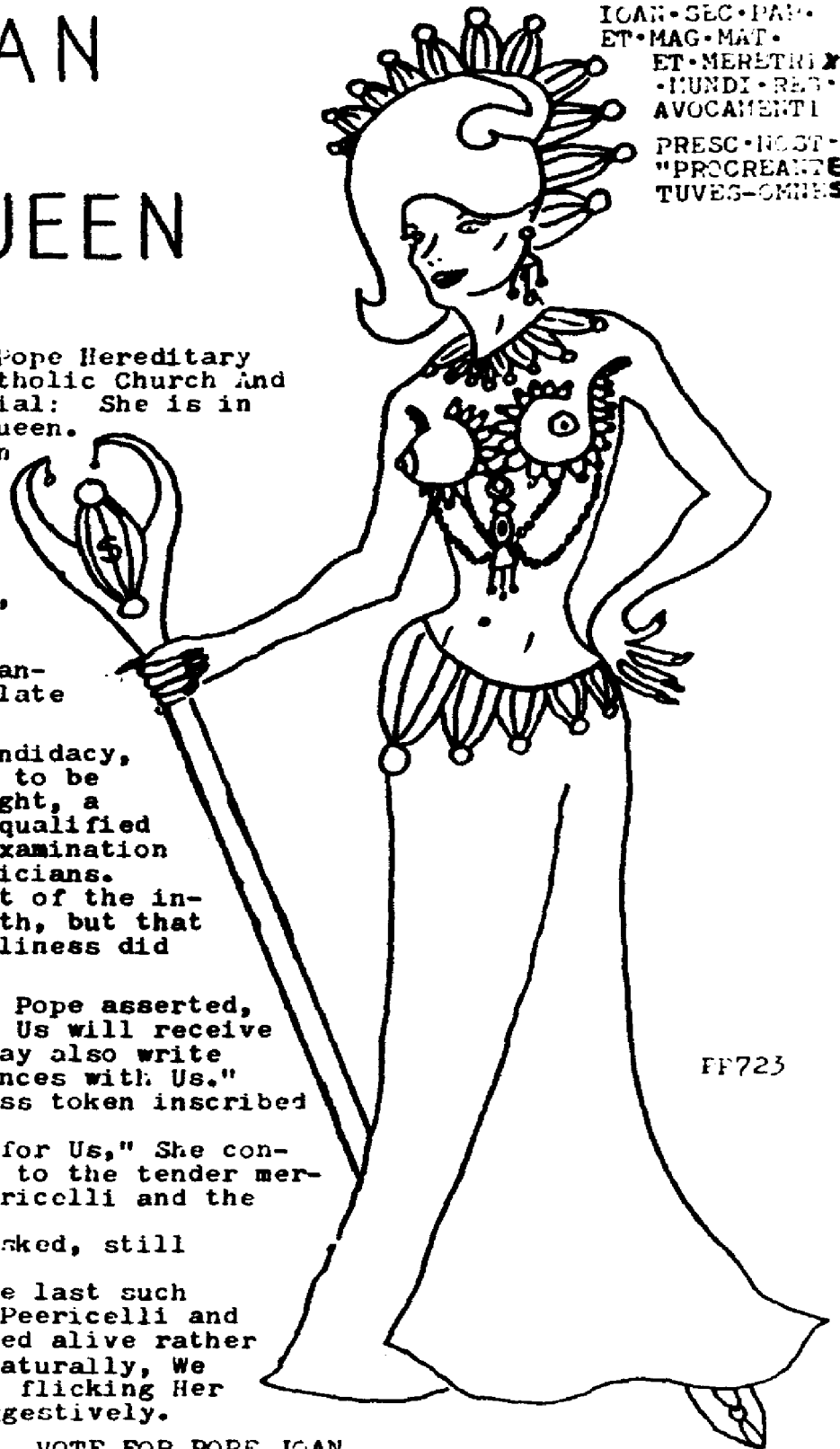

This is being ran just like the LEEDER POLL IN grading zines. But the QUALITY is being rated, not the stuff inside.

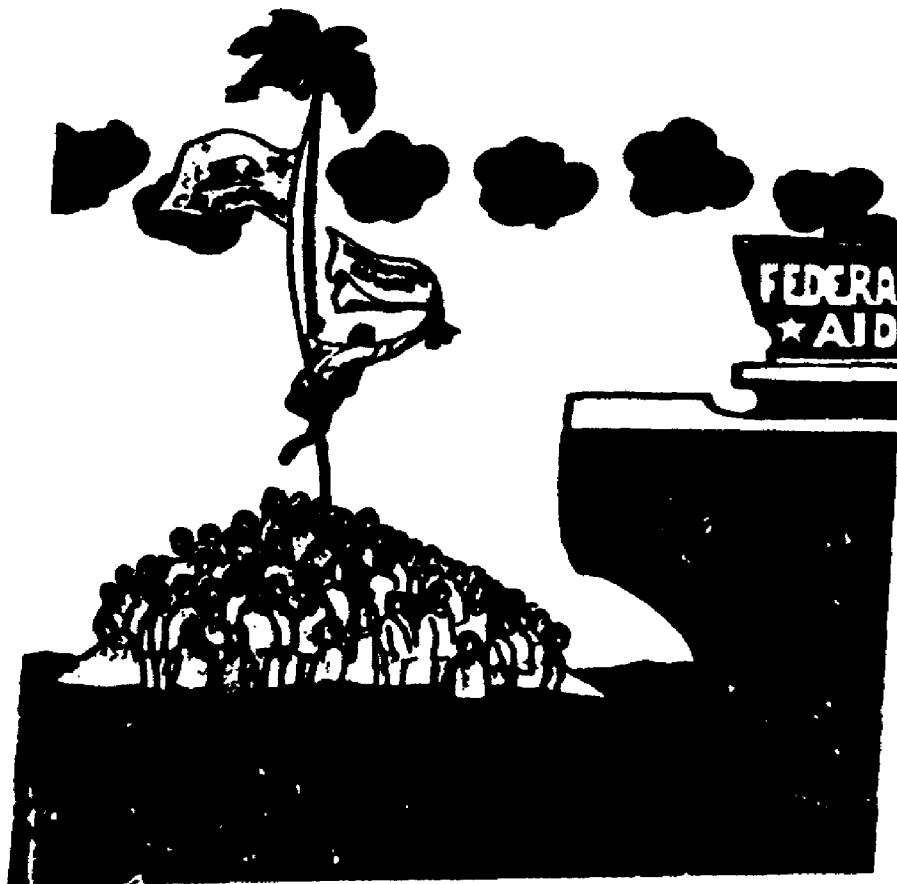
