AGGRESSOR HOMELAND: Extensive analysis of reports from Budapest by the Aggressor Homeland Semantics Task Force indicate that the Austrians have broken up a major smuggling ring run by the Budapest Bears, the local soccer team. Berlin: In a recent press conference, Kaiser Wilhelm Von Klutz unveiled the latest addition to the German war machine. Through years of meticulous research it seems German scientists have developed a chicken roughly the size of a six story building which lays ten foot long eggs weighing in the tons. To effectively put this great weapon to work in the war effort the German General Staff has come up with (you guessed it) the Giant Egg Catapult.
