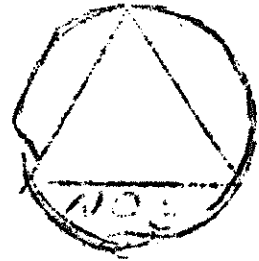


CIRCLE TRIGON
