So Mike has written has sent me chapter 2 this month. He of course is proving that he is my 'harrassment factor' by not typing his own work. Well since I gave Bob Olsen 2 free issues for Mazzer's chapter 1, which Mazzer typed. I have decided to deduct 4 issues from Olsen's COA sub since I have to use my electricity and wear and tear on my typewriter. (I'll fix that Mazzer yet)

Chapter 2 How to Win as Austria, or, Dream on, Sucker! by Mike Mazzer

There is a general misconception that Austria has very little chance of winning. This is not true. Austria has NO chance of winning. If Russia, Turkey and Italy all NMR in fall '01, Austria might, with skilled guidance, achieve a four or five way draw. But don't bet on it. If you have Austria high on your preference list, then do not bother to read the rest of this article, since you are clearly an airhead. If you have the misfortune to have drawn Austria, then this article intends to help you redirect your ambitions so as to make the best of a hopeless situation.

AUSTRIAN OBJECTIVES

1. Getting even

One possible objective for Austria is to get revenge on someone who walked on you in the past. If that person is Italy, Turkey, Russia or Germany, then one good strategy is to, for example, cede your centers to Italy and ally with Turkey against Russia. Or cede your centers to Russia and Turkey and kamikaze against Italy. Or cede your centers to Russia, Italy and Turkey and go after Germany. (for example: Spring '01: Austria- A Vie- Boh, A Bud- Vie, F Tri- H: Italy- A Ven- Tyo, A Rom- Ven, F Nap- Ion: Russia- A War- Sil, followed by fall '01: Austria- A Boh S Russian A Sil- Mun, A Vie- Sil, F Tri-H (defeated and retreats OTB); Italy- A Tyo S A Ven- Tri, F Ion- Gre; Turkey- A Bul- Ser; Austria builds A Vie in winter '01)

2. Building an image

Another possible objective, if you aren't sore at anyone (i.e. you don't know anyone else in the game) is to use the situation to create a "nice guy image". I did this myself in a recent game. As Austria, I got pretty pulped (as usual) by Italy, Russia and Turkey. France, who was even dumber than I, got stomped by Germany and England and soon found himself left with one unit left in Piedmont. I had about two or three units left as Turkey was taking his sweet time about killing me, so I offered to support the French unit to Venice! It was purely for the "image" effect since it had no bearing on the game. France thought I was a saint. He continually wrote me telling me how "decent" I was, and how he fervently hoped to get in a game with me "under better circumstances". I told him I looked forward to it. If we ever do get in another game, I'll cut his liver out. (Unless of, course I draw Austria) In Diplomacy, you must always consider the next game.

3. Propaganda value

To the skilled press writer, Austria offers the greatest opportunity for playing to the gallery. Any Austria worth his salt should be able to wring tears of sympathy from players and spectators alike at his miserable demise. One word of caution: Occasionally, just occasionally, you will get Austria and have mental midgets as Russia, Turkey and Italy, and Austria might be able to gain centers early. Resist this temptation at all costs! Remember, when you are Austria, victory is but a mirage. Rapid growth only destroys your opportunity to reap propaganda benefit. And there is nothing more heartbreaking then watching an Austria surge to 10 in 1903, only to be reduced to 2 in 1904. For example see Woody's Austria in 82W, or Bob Olsen's in 79KW. To his credit, Bob learned from his early catastrophe and is now the consummate master as Austria. There is no one who can milk sympathy while his Austria is being crushed like an insect. It is Bob Olsen who should be writing this chapter.

The following is yet another contribution which was received UNtyped! What are Typewriters a luxury item outside of Phila? Here we have a game developed by our very own "Naked Man" Gregory Stewart. Greg did not name the game so let's call it the Naked Game.

1. Use standard wargame procedures.
2. Numbers at top are: Attack- Defense-Movement
3. Limit of 2 per stack
4. When attacking, roll one die per unit attacking. If a "G" is rolled for a particular unit, then that unit must use his/her power. Otherwise normal combat.(see combat table)
5. Player sequence: A. General's army moves, B. General's Army combat
C. Desperate Army moves, D. Desperate Army attacks E. Go to next turn
(roll die to see where dog goes)

** Combat
1. Roll die for powers (defender also rolls die for power)

2. use powers if applicable 3. normal combat

6. Victory condition: Eliminate other players 'key piece'. At the start each player assigns one unit as himself or his key piece. Loss of key piece is eliminated, key piece is secret, just write the name of your key piece on a piece of paper at game's out set.

7. Zones of control; optional

8. POWERS

DESPERATE MAN: Evil genius, capable of eliminating any adjacent unit immediately
Desperate man's choice.

SPIDER SWIDER: Poisonous spider juice, -1 on enemy combat roll

WOODY: Woody runs in panic full movement factor

HOBBIT SLOSSAR: Spitball, break off combat immediately

HART ATTACK: Roll die, 1 or 2- Hart dies, 3, 4, or 5 nothing 6-adjacent enemy dies
(enemy choice)

CARUSO: Can Hail in any friendly unit to this combat immediately

C. CUNNING: Charm enemy not to defend himself this round (defense 1)

RUSTY SPOON LEUDI: Digs big hole, adds 4 to his defense factor this turn

ANCIENT ANDERSON: Dies from old age

GOLDEN ARCHES HANSON: Causes one enemy (enemies choice) to flee battle scene due to
diarrhea

DEL GRANDE: Joins enemy

MAGUS LANGLEY: Magic zap, adds 4 to his attack factor this round

KATHY BYRNE: Cannot be eliminated this turn

IG LEW: Freezes all units adjacent for one turn

COWBOY HAT: Throws boomerang steel cowboy hat, get free attack on any enemy unit
within 3 squares without penalty to Pearson

ERICANE: Produces scroll which can cancel enemy power one time. May use anytime after
scroll is produced.

ORC OZOG: Causes one enemy (orcs choice) to flee

MOS EISLEY MICHALSKI: Nukes a square, roll 1- Miss, 2- enemy unit destroyed, 3- miss
4- Michalski destroyed, 5- Enemy unit destroyed, 6- Michalski and enemy destroyed

DUCK WILLIAMS: May fly anywhere next movement phase

BARNO: USES shogun's sword, add 4 to either combat or defense factor this turn.

GENERAL FAREWELL: Dispatch orders; bring up any allied unit of choice into combat

SCIENTIST HAIL: Uses stolen desp device to destroy any adjacent enemy unit.

BERCH: SURRENDERS AND IS REMOVED FROM BOARD

DETROIT OSBORNE: Motwn power, reassemble one unit of choice (1,2 enemy unit
3,4,5,6 allied unit)

***Well, here's your last letter. Readers, let me know if I was right in not printing it or not (I think I already know what the answers are going to be like...).


"Dear Cor,

Indeed the Smurfs (in French: "les Schtroumpfs") are quite old. They made their first appearance in LA FLUTE A SIX SCHTROUMPFS (The Flute with six Smurfs), a Belgian comic strip, in the later 50's. Since then, their "father", PEYO, has published about 20 stories of which their are the heroes, and even produced a full-length cartoon about them.

Speaking of films, I liked DAS BOOT, but not THE WORLD ACCORDING TO GARP nor HISTORY OF THE WORLD PART I. For 1982, my selection would be Yilmaz GÜNEY's YOL (The Leave)(and it's Yilmaz, not Yimaz...), THE FRENCH LIEUTENANT'S WOMAN, and François TRUFFAUT's LA FEMME D'A COTE (The Woman next Door). In fact, Brussels is a movie freak's paradise: it has the highest proportion of cinemas per capita in the world after Grenoble (120 cinemas for 1,000,000 inhabitants, plus about 50 film clubs and 16 TV networks), and we have access to almost the whole world production within the year. One big difference with the U.S. is that our cinemas are not operated by film companies, but by individuals. This allows a much larger choice, I think, and lets a greater chance to "intellectual" or non-commercial films. Another difference is that our TV networks are state-operated (with no commercials!) and do not depend upon polls for their programs. Here too, performing non-commercial films is not rare. By the way, I had the chance to attend a congress in Paris last year, the subject of which being "The Role of Intellectuals in our Societies" (I was there as an observer for one of the embassies for which I work, not as an intellectual...). Many American members (among which Susan SONTAG, Saul BELLOW and Noam CHOMSKY) were really amazed at finding out that programs like "APOSTROPHES" (discussions about modern literature) were watched by 6,000,000 enthusiastic French spectators each week.

With regard to food and eating, if "the best way to defeat an army is through its stomach", then all MacDonald owners must be pinkoes, for sure!

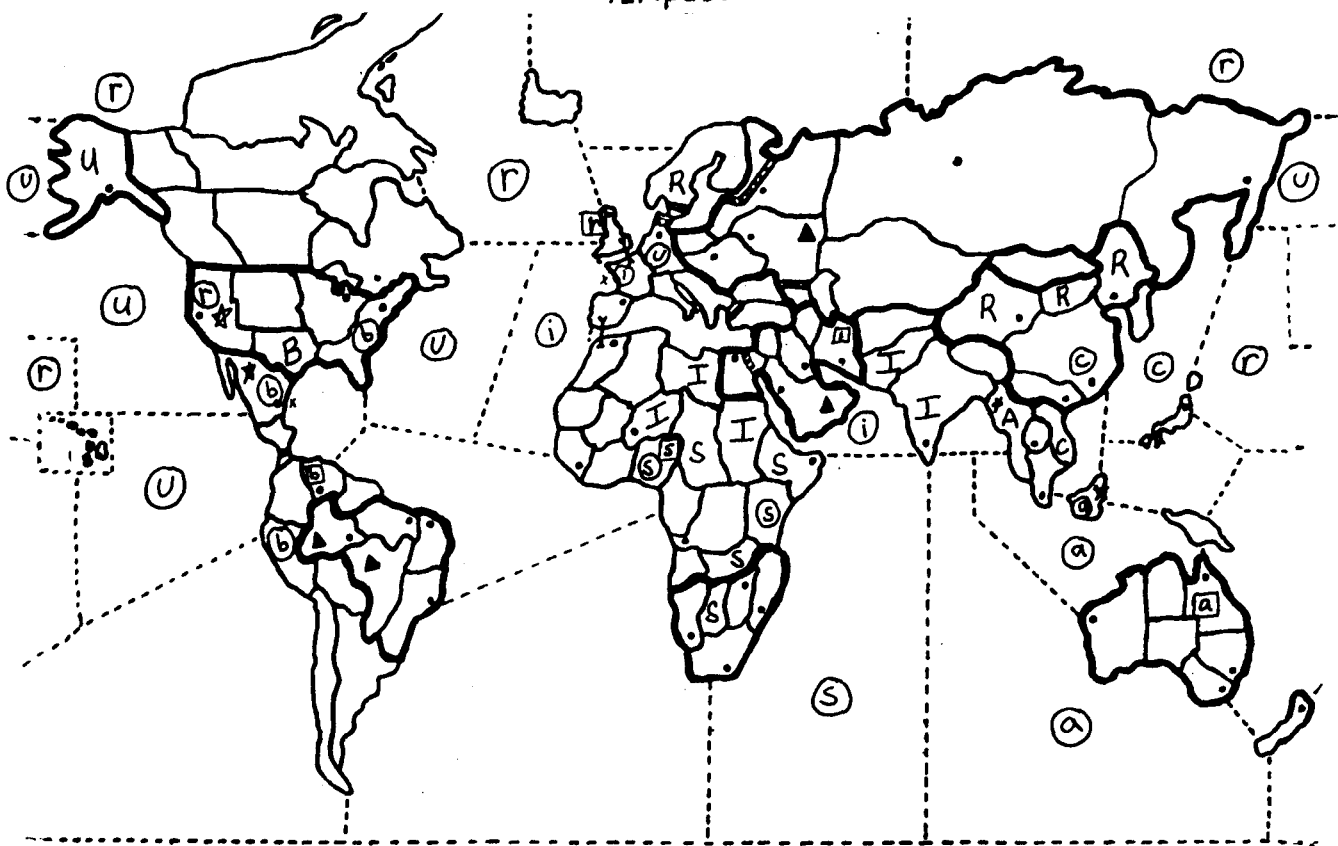

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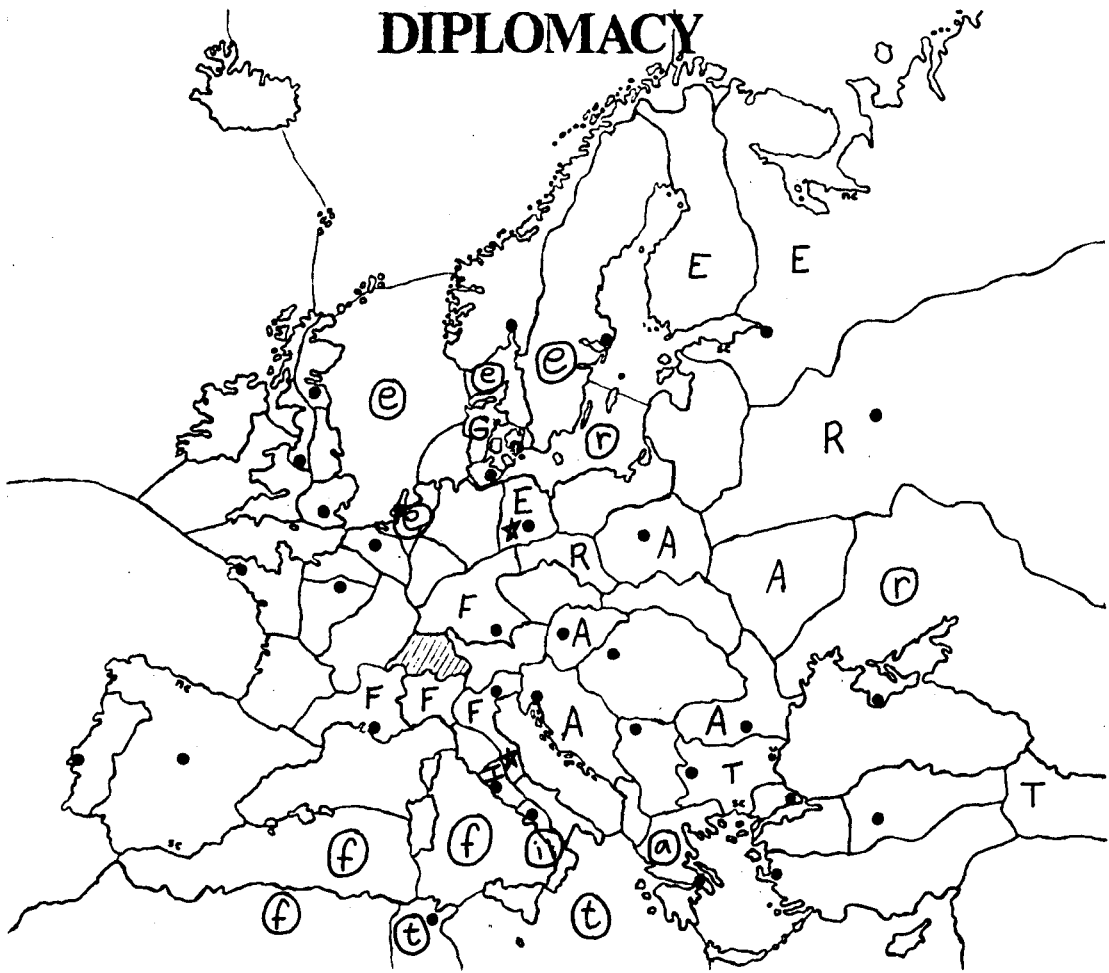

***ED's AMIDAR game is a postal game of Stellar Conquest, a game of galactic exploration and conflict. Normally, the game is played sequentially, but for postal play, turns are done simultaneously. What follows is a short game review of SC.

***Each player begins at a corner of the map and tries to seek out good planets to colonize. At his/her disposal, each player has: Colony Transports (to set up factories to build things), Warships (3 varieties: Escorts, Attack and Dreadnaughts) and Scouts (used to probe the contents of his opponent's taskforces and to search for suitable planets). The player with the mostest wins.

***The interesting aspects of SC are numerous. First, the players are forced to spend money (industrial units) on building warships and technology. Tech allows you to move quicker, build better ships, better defenses and/or build more efficiently. Should one research the Dreadnaught ship, or the robotic factory? It is decisions such as these (and what the other players build and research) that determines the winner. Another interesting aspect to SC is the hidden movement element. Ships move around in task forces, the contents of which are only known to the owning player and those who move onto a planet occupied by the task force. A task force could have just one scout, or a squadron of Attack ships! That's why scouts are invaluable. Normal movement in SC is from planet to planet; each taskforce or ship is given a destination which the player writes down. The ships must procede to their destination

(3) 40 game turn minimum makes for a LONG game(AMIDAR is on 2 week deadlines and is automatically adjudicated once all orders are on file, so it should take at most 2 years to complete! Now I see the advantage of playing Monopoly!) It costs about \$10. Not a bad buy. If you can't find SC in a local store, ask for it through Judge's Guild (address listed in ED #12).
