This last Friday, Oct. 28, moves were due on both running CORSAIR games, RS66:1 and RS66:2; of the total of eleven players in the two games, three turned in moves, and one of these was late by about three hours.... Therefore, there are no moves to be written up here. As there was a bomb scare at the high school which undoubtedly fouled everything and confused a lot of people, perhaps there is some excuse here. So, the deadline has been moved up until November 4, 1966. I hope this is satisfactory to everyone. However, if a similar occurrence happens again, ~~it~~ either or both games will be dropped.

I hope the players in RS66:2 use the extra time to advantage in preparing alliances. The alliances, or lack of same, are extremely important, especially at the beginning of a game, as various people in the first game can tell you. The ones who did not make alliances (and some didn't even try) are the ones who are losing, and are also the ones who seemingly don't give a damn about the game.

The first game, RS66:1 (with the two super-collegians Dunigan and McDermott) is now published every two weeks, barring some unforeseen delay, and moves are due two weeks apart, with build orders due one week after the Fall moves have been turned in.

The second game, RS66:2 (Game of the Love-starved Women) is weekly, meaning just that--Spring, Fall, build orders are due one week apart, on Friday.

The alliance worked fine for Russia, although Austria and Germany were having a tough time in the west, especially from France. The alliance held in the West, ~~with~~ with Germany and Austria slaving away to keep the French and secondarily the English and Italians out, while I in Russia nopped up on Turkey and Scandinavia. The game was not completed, but although Russia had turned against Germany, and France was also gaining, it was agreed to call the game to a close declaring Russia the winner.

A Diplomacy game was played over the Thanksgiving holidays; among the players were: Paul Simpson (England); Bob Kottwitz, France; Mike Jaske, Germany; Bob Speed, Italy; Karl Thompson, Austria; Alan Kissinger (Then Thompson, after Austria was wiped out and Kissinger had to leave), Russia; and Alan Harvey, Turkey. While England, France, and Germany bickered among themselves, with similar help from Russia in Scandinavia, an Italo-Turk alliance (begun by a surprise attack on Trieste from Italy) completely destroyed Austria-Hungary. The alliance had two objectives: 1) total subjugation of Austria; and 2) an even division of the board between Turkey and Italy. The first objective took little time at all, as Austria never rose above four units in strength. The second objective was well on its way toward being achieved when the game broke up in Fall, 1909. At this time, Italy had the most sup. centers, and was attacking Germany and France; Turkey was next with sup. centers, and was making hash of Russia (or maybe borsch) and helping in the German campaign. Russia was surprisingly strong throughout the game, and ended up with seven s.c.; though Russia was gaining pieces in Scandinavia, she was being eaten up from the inside, Turkey was in control of Sevastopol and Norway, and Warsaw shortly to follow.

DURING THE CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS, A GAME WAS STARTED AT SPEED'S HOUSE, AND WAS PLAYED THRU SPRING 1907. THE PLAYERS WERE: ALAN KISSINGER (GERMANY), TIM McDERMOTT (FRANCE), MIKE LONBERGAN (ENGLAND), MIKE JASKIE (RUSSIA), PAUL DURIGAN (TURKEY), KATHY ANDERSON (AUSTRIA), AND BOB SPEED (ITALY). RECORDS WERE KEPT OF THE GAME, AND THESE MAY BE PUBLISHED AT A LATER DATE. AT ANY RATE, CORSAIR WILL CARRY THE REMAINDER OF THE GAME, WHICH IS, AS FAR AS I KNOW, A PRECEDENT; STARTING WITH FALL 1907, IN THE NEXT ISSUE OF CORSAIR. OF THE SEVEN STARTERS, ONLY FOUR REMAIN: ENGLAND, FRANCE (EACH WITH EIGHT UNITS), ITALY (NINE), AND TURKEY (SIX). AS SPEED IS PLAYING, THERE WILL BE AN ASSISTANT GAMESMASTER, ALAN HARVEY. THE OTHER DAY, I received a questionnaire asking my opinion on several situations which have arisen in play during postal games. Apparantly, most or all gamesmasters have been sent similar questionnaires. Some of the questions brought up are quite legitimate, as they have no precedent set up in the Rules of Diplomacy. Several, however, irked me somewhat, because the question is answered in the Rules. I do not personally feel that such questions are really legitimate. I feel that the rules set up in the Rules booklet, along with a little common sense on the part of the gamesmaster will settle nearly all questions; we here in Richland have had some pretty exasperating arguments on a few questions, however, where the rules were not specific. However, on the most part, the rules have been concise enough to ensure smooth play. Of course, the rules are not rigid, and much is left to the interpretation of the gamesmaster; and different gamesmasters will not always agree as to the proper course. This is good, and I, along with everyone else, welcome discussion on points of disagreement. I do, however, feel that questions which are answered in the Rules booklet should be followed, and this is what will dictate my decisions, along with a little knowlege of history and strategy, and a wee bit of common sense.
