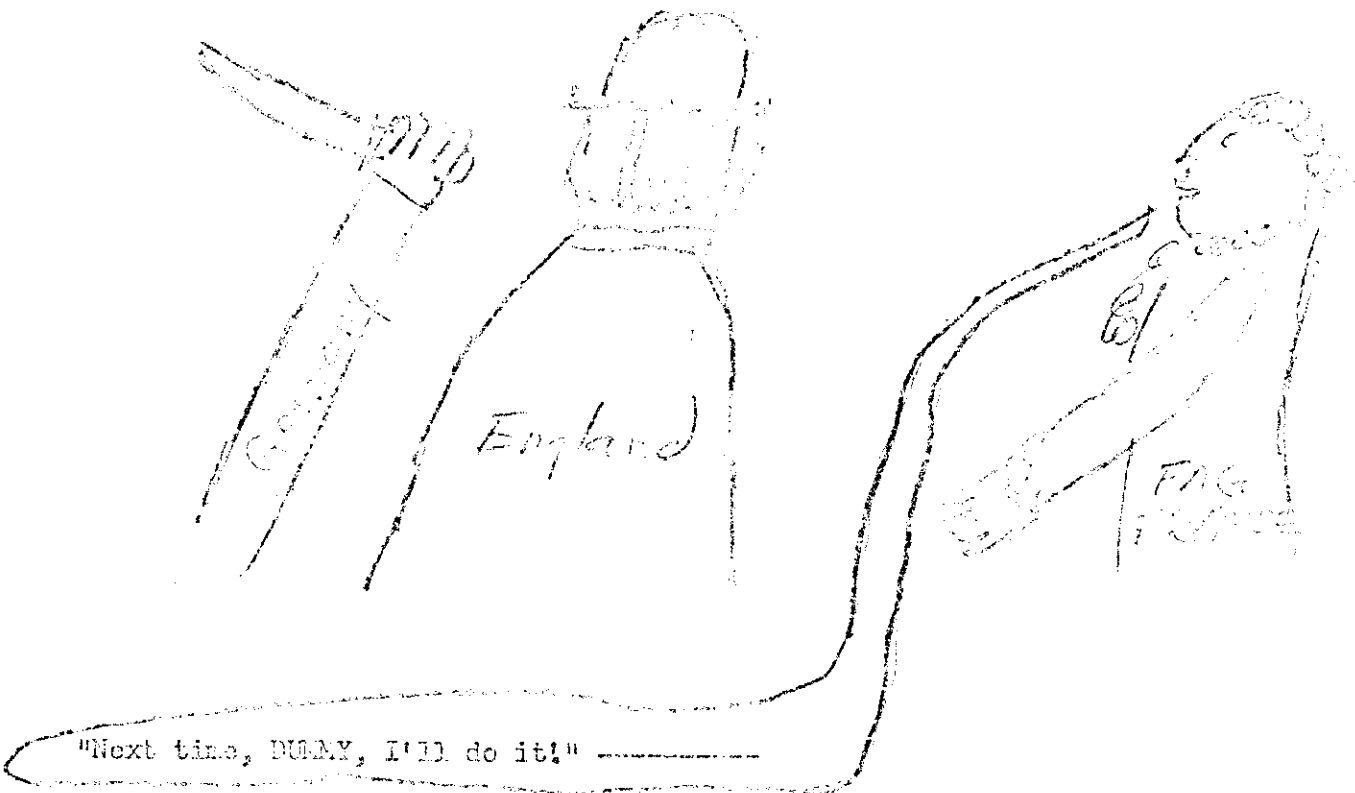
GAME 1

BUILDS for Winter 1901-1902- Italy builds Fleet Naples, Germany builds Army Berlin, England builds Fleet London, Russia builds Armies Moscow and Warsaw and Fleet St. Petersburg(SC), France builds Armies Paris and Brest plus Fleet Marseilles (FRANCE also states that it will welcome England's friendship.), Austria builds Army Vienna. Turkey's build is forfeited for failing to report.

Also a new number will appear along with the JOURNAL'S standard Game I-IV designations. These will appear in order to aid the recorder's of our games. These are called Boardman Numbers. Here are the designations for Games I&II: Game I (1970Y), Game II (1970Z).

### GAME I (1970Y)

Retreats- Fleet North Sea retreats to Norwegian Sea.

Builds and Removals- Russia removes one not two as stated in the JOURNAL. Russia removes Army Warsaw. France builds Army Marseilles and Fleet Brest. England removes Fleet Norwegian Sea. Italy loses its build for not returning notice to the CYCLOPEDIA.

### GAME II (1970Z)

Retreats - None.

Builds and Removals- Well folks, the JOURNAL really blew this section last issue. Here are the corrections: England builds three not two. France removes two not one. Austria builds one not two.

England builds Fleet London, Army Liverpool, Army Edinburgh. France removes Army Tyrolia and Fleet Spain. Russia removes Army St. Petersburg. Austria builds Army Trieste.

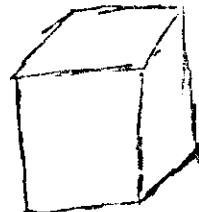

It really has four; they are: Armies Tyrolia and Bohemia, and Fleets Tunis and VENICE. This is the unit that was not reported. Austria's move must be now modified. It stays essentially the same except that army trieste to venice and army budapest to trieste both fail. In the Nov. Journal, it was stated that they succeeded. Also Replace these two entries for the ones appearing in the Nov. issue of the Journal: Builds And Supply Centers- Italy (4) stays the same, Austria (8) stays.

The following are the builds and removals for this winter (Game I): France builds Army Marseilles, England removes Fleet St. Petersburg (HC), Turkey removes Army Smyrna, Germany, Austria, Russia, and Italy stand pat.

## Game II (1970 Z) WINTER 1904-05

KOBELDOMICHTEMS TEIN- Ben Goss also found a mistake for Game II (at least you guys won't feel deprived). Turkey has An Army Constantinople, And Fleets Smyrna and ANKARA. This unit was not reported in the Nov. issue of the Journal.

The following are the builds and removals for this winter (Game II): Austria builds Army Trieste, Germany removes Fleet Helgoland Eight and Army Ruhr, France removes Army Gascony, England builds Fleet London and Army Liverpool, Russia Turkey and Italy stays the same.

## Game I (1970 Y) Winter 1906- 07

Kobeldomichtenstein- A mistake was found in the Game I section of last month's JOURNAL (only one? that must be a new record!). Italy's Fleet Venice can retreat to the province of Apulia, Italy's Army Tyrolia however remains destroyed.

Here are this month's builds: Austria builds a fleet in Trieste, Germany builds a fleet in Kiel and an army in Berlin. That's it for the builds. Turkey (Bosowski) was entitled to one but did not report so it loses its build.

This report from the JOURNAL'S man in Germany came in too late for last month's issue of the JOURNAL so it will appear here as a special added feature of the CYCLOPEDIA!

## Game II (1970 Z) Winter 1905- 06

Here are this month's builds for Game II: Italy builds a fleet in Naples, Austria builds an army in Vienna and an army in Budapest, England builds an army in Liverpool, and Russia builds an army in Warsaw.

Although there was only one mistake found in last month's issue, there was another one that nobody found. In the retreats section, there was a failure to report that Russia's Army Munich must retreat. The retreats are as follows: Turkey's Army Constantinople retreats to Valhalla, ditto for France's Fleet Spain. Russia's Army Munich retreats to Burgundy.

Russia must also remove Army Sevastopol (see note below).

Note: I screwed up last month's builds so much that Rod Walker wrote me a letter explaining the mistakes to me. These revised builds indicate the corrections made. Att. Ben Goss: I placed a Fleet Naples in your pack of armed forces. If you desire an Army in Naples indicate so on your next set of moves. Att. Mike Wright: I read your letter and understood what you meant. However my decision as published in the Journal must stand. Surely you know that an Army can't cut the support of another army directing an attack towards its own province. Please also note that Turkey's Army Gen: was not wiped out as earlier indicated.

Note to all Players

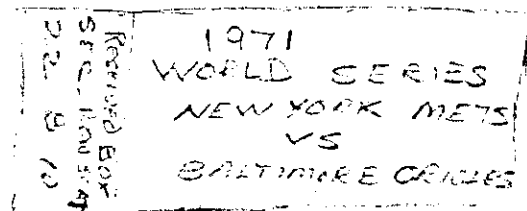

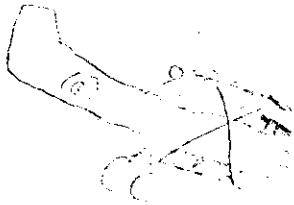
Game I Winter 1909-1910 Adjustments

Kobeldomichtenstein- The following are the changes in the sizes of the Armed Forces of the Almighty Six: Austria-Hungary builds Army Vienna and Army Trieste, Germany builds Fleet Kiel, France builds Army Paris, Turkey removes Army Syria, Italy and England remain inert.

Game II Winter 1908-1909 Adjustments

Kobeldomichtenstein- As Game II slowly sinks into the setting sun with only three effective powers left: England builds Fleet Liverpool and Army London, Austria-Hungary builds Army Vienna and Army Budapest, Italy Stays and Russia removes Army Livonia.
