That's it for now. Please help me out and tell me what you want. I'd appreciate it. Thanks.

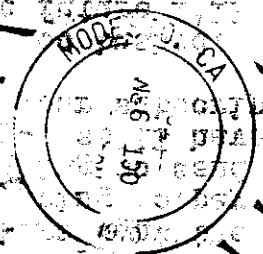
